    - 4. We need to learn from the past but be future oriented because just staying in the past can make us stay stagnant.

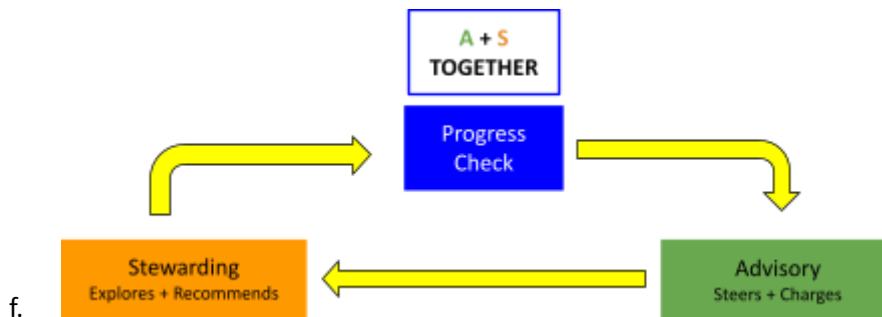
