LAST CHANCE TO PROVIDE PUBLIC TESTIMONY



Q: Do all rules have public hearings?

A: As of now, all rules pertaining to the Student Success Acts will have scheduled public hearings. If a rule does not have a hearing scheduled ahead of time, the public may request a hearing.

Q: How does ODE use public comment?

A: The Oregon Department of Education must consider all public comment received on administrative rules. Staff may use public comment to revise their rules or to help guide discussion with community partners.

Q: How long does the public have to submit testimony?

A: Timelines can vary, but the public generally has 1-2 months to submit testimony.
