 - i. Excited about OHA grant to create paid internships and an internship coordinator to get students out into real world work experiences
 - ii. Rented a store-front for the 2nd year cosmetology program
 - iii. Dental Assistant program has been a valuable investment in our community and in our students
 - iv. Budget committee approved the budget and need to get a tax levy approval to bring forward in June
 - 1. PERS bill passed and will lower district PERS rate by 1.68%
 - 2. May revenue forecast came in 780M lower
 - 3. Waiting on TI funding and Oregon's allocation is about the same as last year, possibly up but still not sure how it will affect RSD
 - 4. Able to use Stronger Connections grant to fund a 5th social worker in the district for one year
 - 5. Received 1M for summer programs
 - 6. Running ESY program called 9th Grade Counts as well as a summer graduation, etc
