## **Student Investment Account Application**

ODE will receive applications from school districts and other eligible applicants from March 2 to April 15, 2020. Applications for the 2020-2021 grant period will be expected to include:

- 1. Evidence of complying with the application requirements outlined above including community engagement processes and application development processes outlined in the law.
- 2. SIA plan
- 3. SIA Budget
- 4. Copies of any relevant district's agreement(s) with charter school(s) eligible to be included in the SIA Application.
- 5. Documentation of board approval of the plan, application, budget and any charter agreements prior to submission. <a href="Note: Longitudinal Performance Growth Targets">Note: Longitudinal Performance Growth Targets</a> will be requested for review but will not be considered by ODE to determine if a district complies with application requirements and won't require school board approval until those targets and corresponding Intergovernmental Grant Agreement (IGA) are co-developed and approved by ODE.
