EVE Workforce Survey

Welcome!

The EVE Workforce Survey is an annual education workforce survey required by Section 4 of Senate Bill 283. The aim is to gather feedback from Oregon's public education workforce about their experiences and perceptions relating to workplace conditions, climate, and culture.

Your participation and responses will help the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) and the state legislature understand and improve the workplace conditions, climate, and culture of schools, districts, ESDs, and other public education providers.

What you need to know before participating in the survey:

Survey participation is **voluntary**. You are **not** required to participate, and your employer **can't** require you to participate.

If you choose to participate, you can **skip** any question you don't wish to answer.

The survey asks approximately **24 questions** about six domains (i.e., workplace climate, professional learning, well-being, students and families, equity, and job satisfaction).

The survey should take **10 to 15** minutes to complete.

Your participation is **anonymous**, and your responses are **confidential**.

ODE will **not** share your responses with schools, districts, ESDs, or other public education providers.

ODE will only use your survey responses as part of **aggregate** and **suppressed** data reporting to protect your anonymity, confidentiality, and trust.

Per ORS 192.355(4), your responses are **exempt** from public disclosure unless you optionally consent to disclosure at the end of the survey.

Only members of Oregon's public education workforce should participate.

Please **only** take the survey once.

Do **not** share the survey link or password with individuals who are not members of Oregon's public education workforce.

When taking the survey, read each question carefully and select the response that is right for you.

You may review and change your responses to each question. Select the **Previous** button at the bottom of each page to view questions on the previous page. The **Previous** and **Next** buttons will help you navigate to the beginning and end of the survey.

Select **Submit** at the bottom of the last page when you are ready to submit your survey. You will not be able to return to the survey after you select **Submit**.
