2017-18 Oregon Statewide Report Card Released

(Salem, Ore.) – The 2017-18 Oregon Statewide Report Card is now available on the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) [website](#). This annual aggregate report provides a roundup view of Oregon’s kindergarten through grade 12 education system including key data on our students, teachers and schools.

“As we work towards our shared vision and commitment to delivering an equitable, engaging and well-rounded education across our state, data provides a clear overview of the challenges we face and the opportunities for excellence ahead of us,” Director Colt Gill said. “While just a snapshot in time of our education system, I hope the data starts conversations about how together we can continue to improve our education system for every student.”

The 2017-18 Statewide Report Card includes a state level view of the following data, most of which has already been released in the last year:

- Graduation and dropout rates
- Early childhood data
- Attendance and chronic absenteeism data
- Student demographics and information on specific student groups
- School funding and staff information
- Test results
- Charter school data and information on alternative education programs
