





ISLAND STUDENTS REPRESENT ABOUT 25% OF SCHOOL POPULATION




ISLAND STUDENTS REPRESENT 53% OF MINORITY POPULATION

LIKELIHOOD FOR KINDERGARTEN ADMISSION WITHOUT CRITERIA


Siblings

Without criteria, the likelihood that any new island student would gain admission is about 9%, or 1 in a class of 24.

ISLAND FACTS


- 26,000 acres and 50 miles of road**

For a resident living next to SIA, First Student estimates 1 hour 25 minutes ride with a bus transfer to Grant Watts, and 1 hour 35 minutes with a different transfer from Grant Watts home, for a total of 3 hours round-trip.


