BACKGROUND

OSBA, ODE, and OSD worked together to create a policy manual to protect the students and staff at OSD. Formerly there had been outdated program guidelines that were no longer reflective of the standards and expectations governing a school in public education.

New leadership at both ODE and OSD and the mutual desire to update practices promoted the change. On the recommendation from the OSD Advisory Board and ODE, OSBA was hired to assist in making the necessary changes and additions to reflect correct best practices.

A new policy manual has been created awaiting the adoption and approval by the State Board.
