## **BACKGROUND**

---

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 327.006 includes supplemental plans approved by the State Board of Education as part of "Approved Transportations Costs. Also, ORS 327.043 requires districts to provide transportation to students identified in a supplemental plan approved by the State Board of Education.

## **SUMMARY OF PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION**

---

Culver School District does not have a current supplemental plan because they have not identified any health or safety reasons to provide transportation to students within the no transportation area.

This year, they have started to transport a student with special needs who is within the no transportation area. By rule, the student must be accounted for on a supplemental plan for the district to be reimbursed for the transportation. The submitted plan includes any special needs student who requires transportation but resides in the no transportation zone.

## **POLICY ISSUE OR CONCERNS (IF APPLICABLE)**

This new plan accounts for the transportation of special needs students within the no transportation area.

**CULVER SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPPLEMENTAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN**


**WHEREAS**, ORS 327.043 states a school district is required to provide transportation for elementary students who reside more than 1 mile from school and for secondary school students who reside more than 1.5 miles from school; and

**WHEREAS**, A district is also required to provide transportation for any student identified in a supplemental plan approved by the Oregon State Board of Education; and

**WHEREAS**, A supplemental Plan means a plan adopted by local school board resolution identifying groups or categories of students who live within the 1 and 1.5 miles limitations and require transportation based on health or safety reasons, including special education; and

**WHEREAS**, Students qualifying under PL 93-112, Section 504 and Special Education students with Individual Education Plans (IEPs) specifying transportation currently live within the 1 and 1.5 mile limitation in the Culver School District; therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Board of Directors of the Culver School District shall include the aforementioned groups of students in a supplemental transportation plan for submission to the Oregon State Board of Education.
