

## 2017 Legislative Requests

Agency #	LC #	DESCRIPTION
58100-001		Every Student Succeeds Act placeholder bill. This bill will contain necessary changes to state law to align it with the new federal law.
58100-003	LC 615	Change name of the Oregon Virtual School District to the Oregon Academy of Online Learning to more accurately describe the program and reduce confusion with other virtual schools/school districts. Remove requirement that contracting be limited to public entities. Update language.
58100-004	LC 618	Add ability to waive fee for open source instructional materials for materials to be considered for approved textbook list. This will increase the ability of all districts (but especially small ones) to take advantage of excellent, free materials that currently cannot make ODE's list of approved texts because they can't afford to pay the fee.
58100-006		Extend the Developmental Delay disability category eligibility, as allowed by federal law, beyond age 5. Federal law allows states to use this category for eligibility up to age nine and extending the age limit would permit schools to serve some elementary children (age cap yet to be determined) that could benefit from services.
58100-011	LC 627	Allow the Oregon Career Technical Education Student Leadership Organization – the foundation – to receive any of the CTSO investments. Currently non-profits are excluded from being eligible recipients.
58100-012	LC 629	Authorizes the Early Learning Council to establish by administrative rule processes and schedules for criminal background checks to conform to new federal law requirements under the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 2014.
58100-013	LC 632	Allow Early Learning Division to protect the names of complainants; Clarify the Early Learning Division's authority to share information among state, federal and local agencies, and; Give the Early Learning Division authority to make available provider-specific information in compliance with federal law.
58100-014	LC 640	Allows for non-expiring child care licenses for Certified Family Child Care, Certified Child Care Centers and Registered Family Child Care Homes.

58100-015		Investing in Oregon’s Early Care and Education Workforce. Creates a workgroup co-convened by the Higher Education Coordinating Council and the Early Learning Council charged with developing a plan to develop articulation agreements between and within the higher education system creating “career-to-college” pathways for Oregon’s early learning work force. Workgroup charged to develop solutions to barriers to articulation, examine and recommend how to develop an applied BA degree program through the community college system, and include information on funding necessary to fully implement the plan.
58100-016		Placeholder on Home Visiting
58100-018	LC 651	More than 7% of national youth identify as a sexual minority, and they face a host of increased physical and mental health risks. Negative attitudes toward LGBTQ youth put them at increased risk for experiences with violence, compared with other students, including behaviors such as bullying, teasing, harassment, physical assault, and suicide-related behaviors. The Youth Development Council’s duties would expand to statewide coordination of services for LGBTQ Youth.
58100-020	LC 657	Increase SSF funding weight for Youth Corrections Education Program and JDEP with supplemental GF of \$3.8 million.
