**ISSUE BEFORE THE BOARD:** ODE Legislative Update

### **BACKGROUND:**

The 77<sup>th</sup> Oregon Legislative Assembly is preparing to sine die; we know this because the t-shirts came out last week ("Keep Calm and Sine Die"). Also because most of the policy committees closed May 31. All bills must now emerge from the two revenue committees, the two rules committees and Ways and Means.

Legislative leadership's targeted adjournment date is June 28; the constitutional adjournment date is July 13.

The department's budget bill has not yet passed, not has the Governor's initiatives, but they have done so by the time of the board meeting.

Attached are the measures that have been passed by both chambers, or are on the second chamber's agenda for a final vote.
