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BACKGROUND

We have convened four workgroups to focus on key areas of the Every Student Succeeds Act. These groups are reviewing the law and flexibility within it in the areas of Standards and Assessment, Accountability, Educator Effectiveness and School Improvement. As of the date of the State Board meeting, the workgroups will have met three times. This information item will update the board on the specific content of each group and any leanings that are emerging as a result of the process.
