ISSUE BEFORE THE BOARD: Forest Grove School District as submitted a revised supplemental plan for approval.

BACKGROUND: ORS 327.006 includes supplemental plans approved by the State Board of Education as part of “Approved Transportation Costs”. Also, ORS 327.043 requires districts to provide transportation to students identified in a supplemental plan approved by the State Board of Education.

Forest Grove School District’s original supplemental plan was approved in 1992. Forest Grove School District has opened new schools since that time, and this plan address a new need.

This supplemental plan will ammend the current plan, and update it for the changes made since that time.


WHEREAS hazardous conditions exist in that students living in those areas must cross the railroad tracks between 4th Avenue and Quince Street to get to school;


