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BACKGROUND

The State Board of Education has the responsibility of approving state academic content standards (ORS 329.045) in the areas of math, science, English, history, geography, economics, civics, physical education, health, the arts and second languages. Oregon Department of Education staff review and revise each topic every seven years.

This year, the physical education standards, because they are overdue for revision, were the first to be reviewed. Currently, there are seven standards that support the physical education curriculum. The National Standards, 2014, now have five standards with Grade-level Outcomes as the basis for what a student should know and be able to do. It is necessary to update the State Standards for physical education

As part of its regular review process, ODE staff empaneled teachers from around the state to review the standards. The Content Panel was representative of grades K-12. The panel consulted other state standards, as well as national standards in the five areas.
