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### **BACKGROUND**

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) was passed in December 2015. ODE staff have been actively engaging stakeholders in the conversation about our plan through community forums and regularly scheduled meetings. Additionally four workgroups were convened for meetings from April through June to provide specific input and to provide the Department with recommendations on which to draft our plan. These four workgroups represented the key areas of Title IA and Title IIA aspects of the law that have some flexibility from No Child Left Behind Act and our most recent waiver.
