2023-24 Alt ELPA User Guide Published

The 2023-24 Alt ELPA User Guide has been updated and is now <u>available</u> via the OSAS Portal. The Alt ELPA User Guide is a required resource for administering the Alt ELPA. Changes for the 23-24 version include more updated directions for navigating the testing platform, updated screenshots, and updated language for the Early Stopping Rule. 2023-2024 Fall Membership Validation

The Fall Membership validation will be refreshed weekly in January starting on January 4, 2024. The validation closes on **January 19, 2024**. Please view your data in the <u>Achievement Data Insight</u> application. The Regional ESD partners will notify those districts that have not yet viewed their data. Validation email notices went out January 3 to districts and institutions that have unusual data compared to last school year. Please view and edit your data as soon as possible, since **no changes will be allowed to First Period Cumulative ADM after January 19, 2024.** Please also be aware that Second Period Cumulative ADM audits take place shortly before this validation closes and you will have limited time to edit First Period ADM if you need to do so to address your audits.
