



## OAKS Science and Social Sciences Tests Now Available

The statewide test window for OAKS Science and Social Sciences tests is now open. Schools and districts may now administer these assessments to students using any of the supported operating systems listed in the [Operating System Support Plan](#). The [TA User Guide](#) has been posted to assist with any questions regarding test administration.

## Weather-Related Closures and School-Level Test Windows

As described in Section 5.2 of the [Test Administration Manual](#), schools may not administer the Smarter Balanced math and ELA assessments until at least sixty-six percent (66%) of the school's annual instructional days have been completed. In light of the weather-related closures which many districts have experienced in the past few weeks, ODE has received questions about whether weather-related closures will impact when schools are eligible to begin Smarter Balanced testing. While schools that have experienced a weather-related closure may choose to delay the start of their school-level test windows, this will remain a local decision. **ODE will not require schools to recalculate their testing dates as a result of weather-related closures.** Similarly, if schools extend the school year to compensate for weather-related closures, they may consider as a *local* decision whether to extend their school-level test windows as long as all testing is completed within the statewide test window.

## Coming Soon! ELPA21 Screener Pilot Registration

The ELPA21 Screener is in the final stages for the upcoming pilot test. As mentioned previously, this pilot will test the functions of an all-online screener for potential English Learners. The ELPA21 online screener will eventually replace the legacy screeners such as Woodcock-Munoz and LAS Links in Oregon. ODE and its test vendor, AIR, are seeking Test Administrators familiar with the administration of legacy screeners to participate in the ELPA21 screener pilot from **February through approximately June, 2017**. Information about the pilot and how to register will be shared in coming weeks with District Test Coordinators and Title III Directors across the state. The hope is that numerous districts will be interested in having staff members participate from schools, testing centers, and welcome centers where students in grades Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> are screened for English Learner identification. ## 2016-17 Test Records Available and Webinar Training **REPEAT**

OAKS Online test records for Science and Social Sciences are available in the Student Centered Staging, Accountability Warehouse Extract (AWE), and Secure Assessment Reports 2.0 (SAR) applications beginning **January 12, 2017**. OAKS Science and Social Sciences records will *typically* be available in Student Centered Staging two days after the student completes a test. **Please note** that there is a one-day lag for changes to test records in Student Centered Staging (district edits or newly loaded records) to be available in the AWE and SAR applications.

There will be a Video Training webinar on **Thursday, January 12 at 2 PM**. This webinar will focus on management of assessment data in Student Centered Staging (i.e., editing posted records; reviewing and correcting errors; applying administration codes) and accessing the test records in the AWE and SAR applications. ## Question & Answer

### ANSWERS TO COMMON QUESTIONS FROM THE FIELD

**Question:** I made changes to the data my district submitted to ODE, but the Achievement Data Insight (ADI) validation doesn't reflect those changes. Why not?

**Answer:** Achievement Data Insight validations refresh on a set schedule. Many validations include a "data as-of date" column, usually the rightmost column, that indicates the last refresh. For example, a data as-of date of December 12 would indicate that any changes made after December 12 are not currently included in the ADI validation. The validation's data owner can tell you when the validation is next scheduled to be refreshed.
