### **ALERT: Chrome 56 ELPA21 Speaking Recording Fix Rolled Back**

On February 22, AIR announced that Google had released a patch for Chrome OS 56 that fixes the ELPA21 speaking recording issues AIR identified on January 26. AIR has just learned that Google has rolled back Chrome OS from the version containing this fix (56.0.2924.101) to an earlier version (56.0.2924.87) due to internal production issues. AIR is in communication with Google to determine when they will be able to re-release Chrome OS 56.0.2924.101. A new announcement will be posted to the portal as soon as Google is able to resolve their internal production issues with the patch. As noted in the last announcement about this issue, AIR continues to recommend that all schools that administer ELPA21 tests on Chromebooks take a practice test on the model of Chromebook they are using and verify that ELPA21 Speaking records correctly before administering the test to students.

### Reminder: Update LEP flags for Exited ELs REPEAT

The ELPA21 testing window for 2016-17 opened on Tuesday, February 7. As described in Appendix B of the <u>Test Administration Manual</u>, only students who are currently designated as ELs or who were reclassified from ELD services *after* February 2, 2017 are eligible to take ELPA21. All eligible students must have their LEP flag set to Yes (Y) in ODE's SSID system (which will then populate student data in TIDE) in order to access ELPA21. All other students, including those students who were reclassified out of the EL program on or before February 2, 2017 must have their LEP flags set to No (N) to ensure they do not inadvertently take ELPA21 when they are not eligible. **Administering ELPA21 to a student who does not meet the eligibility criteria is considered a test impropriety.** If you have any questions, please contact your <u>Regional ESD Partner</u>.

### **ELPA21 Screener Pilot Registration Open Now REPEAT**

Over the past 12 months, a task force with the ELPA21 consortium has been working to prepare the ELPA21 Screener for use in the identification of English Learners in our schools. As part of the quality testing of this new online English proficiency screener, school district staff across the state are welcomed to participate in the pilot study for the ELPA21 screener. The recruitment information for participation in this pilot went to District Test Coordinators and Title III directors on Thursday, February 16, 2017. That information includes the link for registering as a Test Administrator of the screener pilot, and includes the requirements for participation. ### **ELPA21 Screener Pilot Available February 21 REPEAT**

Oregon began its administration of the ELPA21 Screener Pilot on February 21, 2017. The Screener Pilot is available through the TA Interface. However, please note that only *registered Test Administrators* may administer the Screener Pilot, and the Pilot must not be administered in the same test session as other, operational tests. Due to limitations in the system, access to the Screener Pilot cannot be restricted to registered Test Administrators. If you have not registered to participate in the Screener Pilot, please disregard the Pilot in the test selection menu.



If you are not registered to participate in the Screener Pilot and you accidentally include the Pilot in your test session, please pause student tests immediately and alert ODE by submitting a <u>Test Impropriety Report</u> form.

### Accessibility Supports Video Presentation REPEAT

ODE has posted a "2016-17 Accessibility Supports Demonstration Presentation" to the <u>Assessment Administration Resources</u> webpage under "General Accessibility Resources." This presentation includes video demonstrations of the embedded accessibility supports available to students during testing in the online interface. This presentation also includes a description of the tool and which tests each tool is available for using language from <u>Oregon's Accessibility Manual</u> for each embedded support in the presenter notes of each slide. This is an optional resource that may be adapted for local use.

### Non-embedded Signed Interpretation Accommodation REPEAT

Per a review and recommendation by the Oregon Accessibility Panel and review and approval by Oregon's state lead to the Smarter Balanced Consortium, the provision of the non-embedded Accommodation of signed interpretation of the Smarter Balanced ELA and Math assessments for all grades is now allowed. In support of this provision for Deaf/Hard of Hearing (DHH) students who participate in the Smarter Balanced Assessments, updates were made to the current Oregon Department of Education's policy and guidelines related to the appropriate use of this accommodation (cf. Appendix B of the Oregon Accessibility Manual)—including qualifications for anyone who plans to serve as a sign language interpreter for the statewide assessments.

ANSWERS TO COMMON QUESTIONS FROM THE FIELD

Question: Why is my student getting a "No Tests Available" message when logging into ELPA21?

**Answer:** Check the Student Demographic portion in TIDE to see if Limited English Proficiency (LEP) is coded "No" for this student. Only students with Limited English Proficiency coded "Yes" can access the Oregon ELPA21 test. If a student's LEP is incorrectly coded, please contact your DTC or Regional ESD partner. Please note that LEP updates typically take 24-48 hours to appear in TIDE.
