## **District Impropriety Summary Reports**

Under ODE's prior procedure for documenting reported test improprieties, the district superintendent was copied on all letters of final determination sent to the reporting school district. However, under the new procedure started in 2016-17, ODE is no longer preparing letters of final determination except on request. To support DTCs in communicating with their superintendents about test improprieties, ODE will send superintendents a report by the 7<sup>th</sup> of each month that summarizes all test improprieties reported by their district in the preceding month; DTCs will be cc'd on these reports. ODE will send the first summary report to superintendents on March 7 that will include all test improprieties reported in February. These monthly reports will continue through the end of the test window in June. If a district does not have any reported test improprieties for a given month, ODE will not send a summary report for that month.

The summary report will include a table that lists the following information for each test impropriety reported in a given month:

- Date reported
- School where the impropriety occurred
- Type of impropriety
- Whether the impropriety was adult- or student-initiated
- Number of tests impacted
- Test subject and grade
- ODE-approved outcome

#### **Question & Answer**

Answers to Common Questions from the Field

**Question:** How should a Test Administrator (TA) address a student who refuses to speak during the ELPA21 speaking segment?

Answer: Only the student may speak into the microphone; this applies both during the initial microphone check prior to starting the test and during the actual speaking segment itself. Using the practice test prior to the operational assessment, TAs can assist the student in finding a way to record a response of some kind into the microphone so that the student can advance to the next item on the test. If at all possible, the student should attempt to respond to the prompt. For students who express anxiety about speaking, promising practices include having the student say his/her name, or whispering into the microphone. To avoid coaching, it is important that TAs work with students on their test-taking strategy *before* beginning the operational test. If a student refuses to speak when taking the test, and the "too soft" warning appears for the student's response, the student may accept the response and move on to the next item. Please note, however, that speaking items with no response count against the student's domain score and therefore could affect the student's overall proficiency determination.
