QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Answers to Common Questions from the Field

QUESTION: The May 2018 tests are showing in Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE), can those be removed?

ANSWER: American Institutes for Research (AIR) plans to resolve this; however, due to the nature of the resolution, the AIR team has decided to not implement the changes to TIDE in the middle of the 2018-19 school year. The resolution will be introduced next school year. The previous year data does not appear under Plan and Manage Testing, and the data under Participation Report by Secure Student Identification (SSID) displays the date started and date completed; please use this information to distinguish the data from the previous year.
