# iOS 10.3 Now Supported

AIR and ODE are now supporting iOS 10.3 for student testing. AIR has posted an updated <u>Operating System Support Plan</u> that reflects support for iOS 10.3.

# **Chrome OS 57 Now Supported for OAKS and Smarter Balanced Assessments Only**

AIR and ODE are now supporting Chrome OS 57 for student testing on OAKS and Smarter Balanced assessments only. On March 30, AIR identified an issue with the voice recorder that impacts the ELPA21 speaking segment on Chrome OS 57. AIR is still investigating a fix for this issue, and as such, Chrome OS 57 is not yet supported for ELPA21 testing. An update will be provided once more information about the ELPA21 voice recorder is available.

# Disabling ChromeVox Screen Reader

AIR has an identified an issue in which the ChromeVox Screen Reader function in Chrome OS can be turned on upon launch of the Secure Browser. To prevent students from inadvertently using this tool, instructions for disabling the ChromeVox Screen Reader have been added to the Technical Specifications Manual. ## **ELPA21 Screener Pilot Close Date Extended**

As communicated in the <u>February 16 A&A Update</u> article, Oregon is participating in the ELPA21 screener pilot in anticipation of the operational screener going live during the 2017-18 school year. The ELPA21 Consortium has decided to extend the pilot test window through June 2017. Although ODE had previously shared that the pilot will end on May 31, 2017, the screener pilot will now stay active through the end of the day on **Wednesday**, **June 28, 2017**. This will allow schools more time to use the pilot version of the screener for the various student groups that are targeted in the study. # **ELA & ELA-PT Test Settings in TIDE**

Prior to the deployment of Smarter Balanced tests on February 7, 2017, the student test settings page in the newly designed TIDE displayed a single test settings column for ELA tests. Upon deployment of the Smarter Balanced tests on February 7, a configuration of the field tests resulted in this single ELA column being broken out to ELA and ELA-PT columns, where ELA refers to the ELA CAT. Currently, ELA and ELA-PT test settings that are modified in TIDE apply only to the respective test, as they have in previous years. For the remainder of the testing window this year, TIDE will continue to function with both the ELA and ELA-PT columns. Users should continue to apply test settings in TIDE for ELA and ELA-PT separately. For the 2017-2018 school year TIDE will have a single column for ELA, with settings applied across ELA CAT and ELA-PT tests. AIR will ensure that TIDE is configured to a single ELA column for next year's test administration.

#### **New Smarter Balanced Math Performance Tasks**

New Smarter Balanced Math Performance Tasks are now available in the practice tests located at <u>Oaksportal.org</u>. The legacy performance tasks and the new performance tasks will both be available through the remainder of school year. The new performance tasks will replace the previous math performance tasks in the 2017-18 practice tests.

# **Verifying Accessibility Supports Before Testing**

ODE has received a number of test impropriety reports this year of IEP or 504 Plan violations that resulted from Test Administrators approving students to test without their identified accessibility supports. Before approving students to begin testing, it is essential that the TA ensure that each student has all identified accessibility supports activated. For students on an IEP or 504 Plan, the TA should ensure that the accessibility supports assigned to the student match those supports that are documented in the student's plan. TAs can view, and in many cases edit, embedded supports through the student approval screen of the TA Interface.

# Institutions for Accountability Reporting Validation Opens Next Week

The Institutions for Accountability Reporting Validation will open next **Thursday**, **April 20 at 1 PM** in the <u>Achievement Data Insight (ADI)</u> application and remain open through **Monday**, **May 15**. The purpose of this validation is to make districts/schools aware of the institution and contact information that the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) currently has so that districts/schools can make appropriate changes to this information for the upcoming school year. This information is used for ODE reports, including the <u>School/District Report Cards</u>. Please review this information during the validation window. The Third Period Cumulative ADM collection will be open for data submission from **April 20, 2017 - May 26, 2017**. This collection is the submission of Cumulative ADM records for the period of July 1, 2016 - May 1 2017. The purpose of Third Period Cumulative ADM collection is to generate accountability reports including School and District Report cards, Student Enrollment, and Not Chronically Absent.

# ELPA21 Batch 1 Test Records Available April 10, 2017

Batch 1 ELPA21 scores from February 2017 were posted in Student Centered Staging, Accountability Warehouse Extract (AWE), and Secure Assessment Reports 2.0 on the ODE <u>secure district website</u> and also in OAKS Online Reports (ORS) on the <u>OAKS Portal</u> on Monday, April 10. Individual Student Reports (ISRs) and Class Rosters for these records are also available in the Secure Assessment Reports 2.0 application on the ODE secure district website as of Thursday, April 13.

District Test Coordinators may download or review records in Student Centered Staging to edit accommodation or administration codes (see the <u>Test Administration Manual</u>, Appendix C). Please note

that there is a one-day lag for changes to test records in Student Centered Staging (district edits or newly loaded records) to be available in the Warehouse applications (AWE and Secure Assessment Reports 2.0).

#### **Question & Answer**

ANSWERS TO COMMON QUESTIONS FROM THE FIELD

Question: Which speech-to-text software can my student use during testing?

Answer: AIR does not officially support any particular speech-to-text software or perform quality control testing to ensure compatibility between the secure browser, test content, and particular speech-to-text software options. Using speech-to-text software requires that the test be administered in permissive mode (set in TIDE) to enable the speech-to-text software to run while the secure browser is open. Consistent with the guidance in the Oregon Accessibility Manual, districts should ensure that whatever software is used during test administration is consistent with the software students use during instruction. To ensure compatibility before test administration begins, AIR and ODE recommend trying the speech-to-text software with the secure browser using the practice test. Because AIR does not formally support SST software, districts should also note that AIR's ability to troubleshoot compatibility issues is limited.

Question: Why isn't speech-to-text available on mobile devices using the AIRSecureTest App?

**Answer:** Speech-to-text software is external to the secure browser, which requires tests to be administered in permissive mode. However, tests administered on mobile devices, including iOS devices and Chromebooks, use a version of the Secure Browser called the AIRSecureTest App. On these devices, only one app can be open at a time. So, as with other mobile apps, if the AIRSecureTest App is currently taking the focus on the device, no other apps will be allowed to run at the same time. As such, permissive mode and, by extension, speech-to-text software cannot be used on these devices.
