NeoSpeech Voice Pack Updated License Information Now Available

On April 10, AIR announced that the current license keys for the NeoSpeech VW Julie (English) and VW Violeta (Spanish) voice packs for Windows are set to expire on May 3, 2017. Detailed installation instructions and an updated license key are now available in TIDE. They can be accessed by logging in to TIDE, clicking General Resources near the top of the page, and choosing the Download Voice Pack option.

Any schools or districts that are using the NeoSpeech voice packs for testing will need to update the license key information prior to May 3 in order to continue using them. The voice packs will not need to be re-installed if they are already installed on a system.

Any users using a different supported voice pack for Windows or using a different operating system for testing are not affected by this issue. Schools that plan to use the NeoSpeech voice packs but have not yet installed them can use the installation instructions to install the voice packs with the new license key information. For a complete list of approved voice packs, see p. 54 of the <u>Technical Specifications</u> Manual.

ELPA21 Screener Pilot Close Date Extended

As communicated on the February 16 AA Update article, Oregon is participating in the ELPA21 screener pilot in anticipation of the operational screener going live during the 2017-18 school year. The ELPA21 Consortium has decided to extend the pilot test window through June 2017. Although ODE had previously shared that the pilot will end on May 31, 2017, the screener pilot will now stay active through the end of the day on Wednesday, June 28, 2017. This will allow schools more time to use the pilot version of the screener for the various student groups that are targeted in the study. Issue Affecting ELPA21 Records in Warehouse Applications

ODE has identified an issue with the ELPA21 records in the Accountability Warehouse Extract and Secure Assessment Reports applications which resulted in the domain scores not displaying in the correct fields. We have resolved the issue, and all ELPA21 records in the warehouse applications will be end-dated and reloaded on the evening of Thursday, April 20. For users of the Accountability Warehouse Extract or Secure Assessment Reports, you will need to re-download the ELPA21 records or reports on or after Friday, April 21, 2017.

Question & Answer Answers to Common Questions from the Field

Question: WorkKeys is going to be updated in June 2017. Can students use the new WorkKeys assessment to demonstrate proficiency of the Reading and Math Essential Skills?

Answer: The new WorkKeys assessment may not be used to meet the Essential Skills graduation requirement pending review by the Assessment of Essential Skills Review Panel (AESRP) and adoption by the State Board. After the updated WorkKeys assessment is released it will need to be evaluated by AESRP to determine its applicability as an Essential Skills assessment option and to recommend achievement standards equivalent in rigor to the other adopted Essential Skills assessment options. AESRP would then need to submit its recommendation to the State Board for adoption. ODE does not anticipate this process being completed before spring of 2018.

Question: What are the requirements for a student to be considered a participant and receive a score for Smarter Balanced tests?

Answer: The requirements for participation and score calculations are the same as 2015-16. A student will be considered a participant when he/she has completed 5 CAT items **OR** 1 Performance Task item. However, scoring rules require students to attempt both halves of the test before a score is produced. Students will receive a score if they respond to 5 CAT items **AND** 1 Performance Task item. The different scenarios for how participation and scores are calculated are shown in following table:

| At least 5 CAT items? | At least 1 PT Item? | Participant? | Performance Level? | Score is Reported? | Included in achievement calculations? |
|-----------------------|------------------------|--------------|-----------------------|--------------------|---------------------------------------|
| No | No | No | No | No | No |
| No | Yes | Yes | Yes, Level 1 | No | Yes (as not proficient) |
| Yes | No | Yes | Yes, Level 1 | No | Yes (as not proficient) |
| Yes | Yes | Yes | Yes | Yes | Yes |

This creates three categories of students: non-participants, participants with a performance level but no score, and participants with a performance level and score. All participants are included in achievement calculations.
