Assessment: Remote Teaching and Learning Website

The new <u>Remote Teaching and Learning Website</u> provides suggestions for how teachers may use the Oregon Practice Tests, Training Tests, and the Smarter Balanced Sample Items resources while teaching remotely and while their students are learning outside the traditional classroom.

- The Remote Teaching and Learning Website provides educators with videos and planning resources, including a Q&A section, and best practice guidance in the using the practice and sample items as part of collecting evidence of student learning.
- The Remote Teaching and Learning Website includes the new <u>Smarter Item Catalogue</u> that allows teachers to search items to find the content they need to assess their students and where the content is located in the Smarter Balanced system (e.g., interim assessments, Sample Items Website, practice test, etc.).

Distance Learning for All - Instructional Models

The Oregon Department of Education has developed Instructional Model resources to support Oregon educators in the delivery of continued instruction for student learning. These resources can be located in the ODE Guidance section of the <u>Distance Learning for All webpage</u> and provide examples of the differing Instructional Models for Distance Learning for All.

Instructional Models include the following:

- Learner-Centered Model This model focuses on student voice, choice, flexibility, as well as deeper approaches to learning such as inquiry, engineering design process, project-based learning, and design thinking.
- Teacher-Centered Model This model is used to teach specifically to the standards. Instruction takes the form of direct instruction, then demonstration of skills or concepts in a mode directed by the teacher. Skills and concepts covered using this model could then be used flexibly in a learner-centered approach.
- Hybrid Model This model is a happy medium between the two approaches above. Instruction in this pathway may take the form of menus, activity calendars, and more in order to offer choices and options for students and families based on student interest and available resources.

While testing on the English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) Summative has been disrupted by school closures related to COVID-19, scores are still being delivered according to the <u>ELPA Summative Data Delivery Schedule</u> found in the Test Administration Manual. ELPA Summative tests which were completed but not yet submitted as of 3/13/2020 have been force completed and submitted for hand-scoring. These tests will be delivered in Batch 4.
