### Upcoming System Downtime

### 2019-20 District Test Coordinator and Information Only Contact Forms

ODE requires that districts annually designate a District Test Coordinator (DTC) using the District Test Coordinator Designation Form. This form is used to maintain ODE's internal contact database and email listservs. (Please note that this form does not automatically grant access to the TIDE system.) DTCs must register with ODE for the 2019-20 school year by **July 17, 2019**.

Also, please keep in mind that the first required DTC training for the 2019-20 Kindergarten Assessment takes place **Tuesday, May 21**. For anyone that is unable to attend there will be a second training opportunity scheduled for **August 14** (DTCs can [register](#) for the webinar). If your district plans to have a new DTC for the 2019-20 school year, you will either need to ensure that the 2019-20 DTC attends one of the ODE-provided Kindergarten Assessment training opportunities (May 21 or August 14) or have the current DTC participate in the ODE-provided training and arrange to locally provide the 2019-20 DTC a make-up training opportunity prior to the start of the 2019-20 Kindergarten Assessment test window.

## PSAT Update

Beginning this summer, the College Board is making a change to the available gender options. Students registering for our assessments and participating in programs like Student Search Service® will choose from female, male, or “Another, (not listed) \_\_\_\_\_” with the option to fill in the space. “Another” or an abbreviation of it may appear in your reports. We’re enacting this new policy after listening to students, educators, and other key stakeholders, and the change is consistent with the laws and gender reporting guidelines in several states, the District of Columbia, New York City, and many of our member colleges and universities. This change will be added to various College Board programs, websites, and tools throughout the year.
