GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

Revised Writing Scoring Guide

The Revised Writing Scoring Guide was adopted by the State Board of Education in August of 2016 with the following transition plan:

- 2016-17 Districts had the option of using the Revised Writing Scoring Guide or the Legacy Writing Scoring Guide
- 2017-18 Only the Revised Writing Scoring Guide may be used to score Work Samples to demonstrate proficiency in the Essential Skill of Writing. The Legacy Writing Scoring Guide is no longer approved for this purpose.

Posted resources include:

- Student work scored using both scoring guides
- Resources explaining the development
- Information on the validation process to assure that the new rubric **did not** increase rigor
- <u>Resources</u> to support use in the 3-8 classroom, and cross-content use at the HS

Note: There are two versions of the Revised Writing Scoring Guide:

- Narrative writing (personal or fictional)
- Explanatory or argumentative writing

Anticipated Changes to the High School Assessments

On May 10, 2017, ODE released a request for information (RFI) to solicit information from potential vendors about their assessment offerings. Responses to this RFI will help to inform ODE's next steps in the process of identifying the next statewide high school assessments in ELA and math. ODE has also posted a <u>Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)</u> about this process which will be regularly updated throughout the assessment selection process.

Preliminary 2017-18 Test Administration Manual Now Available

The <u>Preliminary 2017-18 Test Administration Manual</u> is now available. The Preliminary 2017-18 Test Administration Manual contains all final policies for the 2017 administration of the Kindergarten Assessment. For all other assessments, the preliminary manual describes anticipated policies. ODE will publish the final 2017-18 Test Administration Manual by **October 1, 2017**. Below is a summary of changes compared to the 2016-17 Test Administration Manual:

- 2017-18 Kindergarten Assessment Training and DTC Training dates (Section 1.5)
- Updated guidance on requesting formal letters of final determination (Section 3.6)
- 2017-18 opt-out notice dates for the statewide summative assessments in Math and English Language Arts (Section 5.3)

- 2017-18 statewide test schedule (Appendix A)
- Updated timeline for exiting students from ELD services (Appendix B)

Question & Answer Answers to Common Questions from the Field

Question: How do we indicate students are on track to graduate in the Freshman On-Track collection?

Answer: Only submit students to the Freshman On-Track collection if they are on track to graduate. Students who are not on track should not have any records in the Freshman On-Track collection. ODE will identify students who are not on track by comparing data from the Freshman On-Track collection to data from Third Period Cumulative ADM, and will display this student-level data in the <u>Achievement Data Insight</u> application for you to review and validate. For more information, see the <u>Freshman On-Track Manual</u> or contact your <u>Regional ESD Partner</u>.

Question: How long will the current version of WorkKeys be available?

Answer: The last date for **online** administrations of the current WorkKeys assessment is September 30, 2017.

The last date for **paper/pencil** forms of the current WorkKeys assessment to be delivered to test sites is June 30, 2017, and all materials that need to be scored must be postmarked no later than August 18, 2017.

This information is also posted on the <u>ACT WorkKeys – News & Announcements page</u>. Note: The revised WorkKeys will begin being available in June, 2017, so it is important to work with the WorkKeys administrator to ensure that you know which version of WorkKeys is being administered.

Question: Who do I contact if there is a technical issue with testing?
