Reminder: Disabling ChromeVox Screen Reader

In recent days, ODE has begun receiving test irregularity reports involving tests where the ChromeVox screen reader was engaged during testing. As a reminder, in the [April 13 issue of the Assessment & Accountability Update](#), ODE included an alert that AIR had identified an issue in which the ChromeVox Screen Reader function in Chrome OS can be turned on upon launch of the Secure Browser. Rather than discontinuing support for Chromebooks, ODE issued guidance directing districts on how to disable the ChromeVox screen reader to prevent students from inadvertently using this tool. Instructions for disabling the ChromeVox Screen Reader have been added to the Technical Specifications Manual. Reporting Issues and Contacting the AIR Helpdesk

In the past two weeks, some districts have reported issues during testing, especially with the Smarter Balanced ELA PTs. AIR has actively been working to investigate and resolve all cases that have been reported to the AIR Helpdesk. As always, districts are encouraged to report any issues to the AIR Helpdesk so that they can be investigated, tracked, and resolved.

In working through reported issues with districts, AIR has identified the following helpful troubleshooting tips:

- Note the date and time (HH:MM if possible) when the student experienced the issue, and provide this to the Helpdesk.
- Confirm if the student's test may have expired (Smarter Balanced CAT tests, OAKS Science and Social Sciences, and ELPA21 tests expire 45 calendar days after they are started; Smarter Balanced performance tasks expire 20 calendar days after they are started).
- If using wireless devices, confirm that an appropriate number of devices are accessing the network at any one time when students are testing so that the wireless access point is not overloaded.
- Reboot the access point if connectivity to the wireless devices seems to be in question.
- Confirm that all applications running in the background are disabled any time the secure browser is open and in use. If the secure browser detects a forbidden application, it will shut down for security reasons.
- Confirm all software and drivers are up to date on the devices being used.
- Disable all Bluetooth receivers on machines and devices used for testing.
- After students complete testing, allow several hours for the latest status information to appear in Plan and Manage Testing. During periods of high testing volume, it may take up to several hours for student test status information to be updated to show if a student has completed and submitted their test.

Chrome OS 58 Now Supported for OAKS and Smarter Balanced Assessments Only

AIR and ODE are now supporting Chrome OS 58 for student testing on OAKS and Smarter Balanced assessments only. As previously reported in an announcement on April 6, AIR identified an issue with the voice recorder that impacts the ELPA21 speaking segment on Chrome OS 57 and as such, Chrome OS 57 was not supported for ELPA21 testing. The same issue found in Chrome OS 57 that impacts the voice recorder was detected in Chrome OS 58. AIR is continuing to investigate the issue with Google. An update will be provided once more information about the ELPA21 voice recorder is available.

ELPA21 Test Administrators: Post-Summative Survey Now Available

The 2016-17 ELPA21 test window closed on April 27, 2017, with 52,470 tests completed. As with 2015-16, ODE and the ELPA21 consortium seek follow up information from those Test Administrators who administered the ELPA21 summative assessment during this year's test window. Oregon's test vendor, American Institutes for Research (AIR), recently emailed all TAs, STCs, and DTCs a survey link so that we could compile Oregon's feedback regarding ELPA21.

The survey takes approximately 5 minutes to complete and also asks for those who are interested in future work opportunities with ELPA21 to provide their information so that they can be contacted regarding opportunities for involvement. ANSWERS TO COMMON QUESTIONS FROM THE FIELD

Question: How do we indicate students are on-track to graduate in the Freshman On-Track collection?

Answer: Only submit students to the freshman on-track collection if they are on-track to graduate. Students who are not on-track should not have any records in the freshman on-track collection. ODE will identify students who are not on-track by comparing data from the freshman on-track collection to data from 3rd Period Cumulative ADM, and will display this student-level data in the Achievement Data Insight application for you to review and validate. Question: What policy document should I be referring to for accessibility supports for statewide assessments?

Answer: The official manual for accessibility supports is the [Oregon Accessibility Manual](#). No other policy documentation should be referenced for Oregon's statewide assessment system unless explicitly stated in [Oregon's Test Administration Manual](#) or the [Oregon Accessibility Manual](#).
