## TEST ADMINISTRATION

### ELA, Math, Science, and SEED Survey Test Windows Extended to June 17, 2022

ODE has determined that the spring 2022 test window will be extended in the hopes that it allows districts that will still be in session to continue making our summative English language arts, mathematics, and science assessments available. We will also make the Student Educational Equity Development Survey (SEED Survey) available during this time to support the centering of student voice in our assessment landscape.

The spring test window is hereby extended to **June 17, 2022**, a two-week extension. This extension applies to our general and alternate summative assessments in ELA, math, and science, as well as the SEED Survey. The test window extension will be incorporated into TIDE by May 31, 2022.

## ELPA

### ELPA21 EL Educator Toolkit Link Expires July 1 **REPEAT**

ELPA21, the test vendor who develops Oregon’s English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA), developed and released a 2021-22 Educator Toolkit. The Toolkit is **free** to Oregon educators. The [one-use download form](#) is active until July 1, 2022. (After this date, the Toolkit must be [purchased](#) at \$199 per Toolkit, even by educators in ELPA21 member states.)

The Toolkit was developed by educators from ELPA21 member states (including Oregon) and contains infographics, tip sheets, student profile templates, and performance tasks (aligned to Oregon’s ELP standards).

In addition, ELPA21 will support this Toolkit with a “Toolkit enhancement” to be released in 2022-23 (and perhaps future years). This enhancement will include supplementary information and new performance tasks. Like the original toolkit, the enhancement will be free to ELPA21 educators during the school year, after which it will be available for purchase. While the enhancements can be used independently, they will build upon earlier resources and will provide the most comprehensive value when used in tandem with the original Toolkit.

The Toolkit download form asks for an email address and associated ELPA21 member state. Email addresses entered in this form will be signed up for the ELPA21 newsletter, but will not be used for any other purpose.

## KINDERGARTEN ASSESSMENT

### 2022-2023 Oregon Kindergarten Assessment

ODE and Early Learning Division (ELD) presented the initial plan for developing a redesigned tool to replace the OKA to the Oregon State Board of Education. The process of redesigning that tool will be referred to as the “Early Learning Transition Check-In: A Collaborative Engagement with Community.”

One piece of the process is piloting a family interview, fall 2022. District test coordinators and ESD partners assisted with gathering volunteer schools. Selected schools will be confirmed by May 27, 2022. ODE will directly be in communication with these districts and schools and will provide training information with those confirmed participants. Community engagements during 2022-2024 will determine if other components are necessary. Early literacy, early math and approaches to learning will **not** be part of the 2022-2023 pilot.

District Test Coordinators may download or review records in the ARUA to edit accommodation, modification, or administration codes (see the [Test Administration Manual](#), Appendix C). **Please note** that there is a one-day lag for changes to test records in the ARUA (district edits or newly loaded records) to be available in the Warehouse applications (AWE and SAR).
