## Student Centered Staging Open for Editing 2016-17 Test Records

Student Centered Staging is open for editing 2016-17 test records as of 9 AM on Tuesday, June 6. All 2016-17 subjects will close again at **5 PM on Friday, June 9** for preliminary Report Card processing over the weekend, and will re-open for editing by 9 AM on **Tuesday, June 13**.

### Staging Components Completed:

- OAKS Extended Assessment records (English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science) are available as of May 26. (OAKS Extended Assessment records submitted by April 27 for grade 12 students were available on May 12.) District Test Coordinators who wish to view or download records for students who took an Extended Assessment in 2016-17 may select the Test Type “Extended Assessments” when searching for records in Student Centered Staging, Accountability Warehouse Extract (AWE) or Secure Assessment Reports.
- Virtual records have been created that indicate non-participation of required English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science assessments based on data submitted in the Third Period Cumulative ADM collection for enrollment on May 1, 2017. A virtual record is created for the student if there is not a valid test in the required content areas as described by the grade of enrollment in the ADM collection. **NOTE:** about 97% of the Smarter Balanced English Language Arts and 91% of Smarter Balanced Mathematics test records are currently loaded, so there are more virtual records at this time that will be deleted as we receive and process the remaining Smarter Balanced records.
- Accountability flags (such as RCSchlPartic, RCSchlPerf and ParticSchlInstID) have been filled on all records that were loaded by Friday, June 2 indicating which tests are used for accountability reporting. These fields are not available in the Student Centered Staging download file, but the full set of fields will be available through the AWE Student Extract or Bulk Download option. PLEASE NOTE that there is a one-day lag for changes to test records in Student Centered Staging (district edits or newly loaded records) to be available in the Warehouse applications (AWE and Secure Assessment Reports).
- Student group information such as race/ethnicity, special education, and other program flags have been filled on all records that were loaded by Friday, June 2 from Third Period Cumulative ADM for students enrolled on the first school day in May (except the Migrant Education Flag, which is filled from the OMSIS). - Virtual ELPA records have been created that indicate non-participation of the required ELPA21 test for English Learner (EL) students, based on data submitted in the Title III: English Learners collection as of June 2. A virtual ELPA record is created for the student if there is not a valid ELPA21 test for any student identified as eligible for EL services during the current school year. (The EL collection will be open for review until **June 19, 2017**.)
- **PLEASE NOTE:** First-year EL students with a virtual record will **NOT** be counted as a non-participant if the student has a valid ELPA21 test (indicated with data field LEPFg = ‘B’ on the test record).

**Staging Components Not Yet Completed:**

- OAKS Online tests partially completed (aka “Partials”) in Science and Social Sciences (to be completed by **June 23, 2017**)
- Smarter Balanced English Language Arts and Mathematics tests taken mid-May through June 9 (to be completed by **June 30, 2017**)
- Smarter Balanced tests partially completed (aka “Partials”) in English Language Arts and Mathematics (to be completed by **July 7**)

**Achievement Data Insight Validations Opening**

The Not Chronically Absent and Student Enrollment validations open at 1 p.m. on **June 8**, and the Assessment validations (English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science) will open on the afternoon of **June 15**. These validations will remain open through **August 18**. The validations are accessible through the [Achievement Data Insight](#) (ADI) application. Contact your [district security administrator](#) if you do not have access to the application, or if you do not see these validations once you access the application. Please review your data during this window. **No changes to the underlying data will be allowed after August 18**. **Question & Answer****ANSWERS TO COMMON QUESTIONS FROM THE FIELD**

**Question:** In Class Roster, I received an error stating that the Instructional Unit Identifier (ChkDigitInstrctUnitID) matches an Instructional Unit record but the demographics (DistInstID, SchlInstID, SchlSctnID, SchlCrsID, CrsCd, CrsBeginDtTxt) must also match. What do I do to fix this?

**Answer:** This error is stating that something in your Class Roster record does not match that same field in your IUID record in the IUID collection. So, you must first identify what doesn't match. Open up your error and look at what has been listed for these fields (DistInstID, SchlInstID, SchlSctnID, SchlCrsID, CrsCd, CrsBeginDtTxt). Then, go into your IUID collection and open up that IUID record. Compare these same fields for this IUID record with what you've submitted in Class Roster to find out which field or fields do not match.

Once you've identified your error, if the IUID record has the correct information, then simply change this information in your Class Roster error and click on save. This will resolve your error. However, if the IUID is incorrect, you will need to create a whole new IUID record with the correct information. Once you receive your new IUID number, go to your Class Roster error and change the IUID number to the new number that has been assigned. You will need to do this for every record using that old IUID number that was incorrect.
