2016-17 District Test Coordinator and Information Only Contact Forms

ODE requires that districts annually designate a District Test Coordinator (DTC) using the District Test Coordinator Designation Form. This form is used to maintain ODE's internal contact database and email listservs. (Please note that this form does not automatically grant access to the TIDE system.) As stated in the Preliminary 2016-17 Test Administration Manual, DTCs must register with ODE for the 2016-17 school year by **August 1, 2016**.

Forms must be completed, signed by the district superintendent, and submitted by **August 1, 2016** to <u>Jordan Heide</u> by e-mail or fax at 503-378-5156.

Also please keep in mind that the first required DTC training for the 2016-17 Kindergarten Assessment has already taken place, with a second training opportunity scheduled for **August 17**. If your district plans to have a new DTC for the 2016-2017 school year, you will either need to ensure that the 2016-2017 DTC attends one of the ODE-provided Kindergarten Assessment training opportunities (May 25 or August 17) or have the current DTC participate in the ODE-provided training and arrange to locally provide the 2016-17 DTC a make-up training opportunity prior to the start of the 2016-17 Kindergarten Assessment test window.

2016-17 Kindergarten Assessment Data Collection Resources – Now Available

ODE has created additional guidance documents available to schools and districts to assist them with the Kindergarten Assessment Data Collections submission process, and is posted to the <u>Kindergarten Assessment Resource District Webpage</u>. Kindergarten Assessment resources can also be found on the <u>Schedule of Due Dates (SoDD) webpage</u>.

2016-17 Kindergarten Assessment Braille Order Form

The 2016-17 Kindergarten Assessment Braille Order Form is now available online at http://www.ode.state.or.us/search/page/?id=625. Districts may place their order at any time through October 7, 2016; however, districts should keep their local Kindergarten Assessment test window in mind when ordering Braille forms to ensure that they are able to complete testing within the first six weeks of the district's school year. Once a district places their order, ODE will work with the regional Special Education program and Teacher for the Visually Impaired (TVI) assigned to support the student to locally emboss copies of the student booklets; districts should allow up to 5 business days after placing their order for processing.

Please note that ODE will no longer process orders for Large Print versions of the student booklets. The standard version of the student booklets are printed in 24 pt font, which exceeds the 18 pt font specifications for large print. For those students who require additional enlargement, districts may locally enlarge to meet the student's individual needs, consistent with the Oregon Accessibility Manual http://www.ode.state.or.us/go/oam.

PSAT Achievement Standard for Reading; Status of Achievement Standard for Math REPEAT

ODE has now received the final PSAT concordance tables (showing the scores on the old and revised PSAT that would have been met by the same percentage of students) from College Board.

- Because the final concorded reading score is the same as the preliminary concorded score, the
 reading achievement standard on the revised PSAT is 24 and is effective immediately for all
 students.
- Because the final concorded math score is 24.5, but the preliminary concorded score was 24,
 AESRP will convene on June 1 with plans to develop a recommendation for the State Board to
 adopt 24.5 as the math achievement standard on the revised PSAT. Pending AESRP's
 recommendation, this score would go to the Board on June 22 for adoption.

As a reminder, a math achievement standard on the revised PSAT has already been adopted for students pursuing graduation in 2016, and this would not change based on the final concordance results.

• A score of 24 or higher on the revised PSAT math test may be used by students pursuing graduation in 2016 to demonstrate proficiency on the math Essential Skill.

Students who are pursuing graduation in 2016 but do not graduate would need to meet the final PSAT achievement standard.

Student Centered Staging Open for Editing 2015-16 Test Records

Student Centered Staging is open for editing 2015-16 test records as of 9 AM on Tuesday, June 7. All 2015-2016 subjects will close again at **5 PM on Friday**, **June 10** for preliminary Report Card processing over the weekend, and will re-open for editing by 9 AM on **Tuesday**, **June 14**.

Staging Components Completed:

- OAKS Extended Assessment records (English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science) are available
 as of May 27. (OAKS Extended Assessment records for grade 12 students were loaded on May 13.)
 District Test Coordinators who wish to view or download records for students who took an Extended
 Assessment in 2015-16 may select the Test Type "Extended Assessments" when searching for records
 in Student Centered Staging, Accountability Warehouse Extract (AWE) or Secure Assessment Reports.
- Virtual records have been created that indicate non-participation of required English Language Arts,
 Mathematics, and Science assessments based on data submitted in the Third Period Cumulative ADM
 collection for enrollment on May 2, 2016. A virtual record is created for the student if there is not a
 valid test in the required content areas as described by the grade of enrollment in the ADM

collection. **Note:** about 97% of the Smarter Balanced English Language Arts and 94% of Smarter Balanced Mathematics test records are currently loaded, so there are more virtual records at this time that will be deleted as we receive and process the remaining Smarter Balanced records.

- Accountability flags (such as RCSchlPartic, RCSchlPerf and ParticSchlInstID) have been filled and
 indicate which tests are used for accountability reporting. These fields are not available in the Student
 Centered Staging download file, but the full set of fields is available through the AWE Student Extract
 or Bulk Download option. Please note that there is a one-day lag for changes to test records in
 Student Centered Staging (district edits or newly loaded records) to be available in the Warehouse
 applications (AWE and Secure Assessment Reports).
- Subgroup information such as race/ethnicity, special education, and other program flags (except the Migrant Education Flag) have been filled from Third Period Cumulative ADM for students enrolled on the first school day in May. Staging Components Not Yet Completed:

- English Language Proficiency Assessment for the 21st Century (ELPA21) virtual records based on records submitted in the Limited English Proficiency (LEP) collection (to be completed by June 14, 2016)
 - **Please note:** After this weekend's processing, First-year LEP students with a virtual ELA record will be counted as participants if they took the ELPA21 (indicated with data field LEPFg = 'B' on the virtual record). ELPA21 records will not be loaded until fall/winter 2016.
- OAKS Online tests partially completed (aka "Partials") in Science and Social Sciences (to be completed by June 24, 2016)
- Smarter Balanced English Language Arts and Mathematics tests taken mid-May through June 10, 2016 (to be completed by July 1, 2016)
- Smarter Balanced tests partially completed (aka "Partials") in English Language Arts and Mathematics (to be completed by **mid-July**)

Student Enrollment Validation Opens Today, June 9, in ADI

The Validation for Student Enrollment opens today, June 9, at 1 PM and will remain open until **August 19**. Student Enrollment includes all students attending your school or district on the first school day in May, as submitted in the 3rd Period Cumulative ADM Collection.

The accuracy of these data is important because the data are used to populate the School and District Profile sections of the School and District Report Cards. All data comes from the spring membership record except for the English Learner/LEP data.

To view the Student Enrollment data, log in at the <u>District Site</u> and select Achievement Data Insight (ADI). Then, click the Student Enrollment Validation tile to view the Student Enrollment Validation. You cannot

change your data in the ADI system. If your data need to be changed, you will be able to do so in Third Period Cumulative ADM via the audit window until **June 10**. After this date, please contact <u>Emily Bowen</u> at 503-947-5831 to request an extension. The last date to make any changes to Third Period Cumulative ADM will be **Friday**, **August 19**. If your data are correct, you do not need to confirm this anywhere, but all districts should log in to view their data.
