# **2020-21 District Test Coordinator and Information Only Contact Forms REMINDER**

The is a reminder that ODE requires that districts annually designate a District Test Coordinator (DTC) using the District Test Coordinator Designation Form. This form is used to maintain ODE's internal contact database and email listserves. (Please note that this form does not automatically grant access to the TIDE system.) DTCs must register with ODE for the 2020-21 school year by **July 29, 2020**.

The Staff Retention and Experience Validation is open as of June 11, 2020 at 1:00 PM. The validation will close on August 21, 2020. The Staff Retention and Experience Validation compiles data from the Staff Position collection and produces the Same Principal Metric, Teacher Retention Rate, and the Percentage of Licensed Experienced Teachers. # High School Entry Year Appeals for Students First Entering High School After March 13, 2020 REPEAT

The High School Entry Year (HSEY) is the first school year in which the student attended any high school grade in the United States or elsewhere. For most students, the HSEY is their first year as a 9<sup>th</sup> grader. All students who are, or have been, enrolled in grade 9 or above must be identified with a HSEY for the cohort graduation calculations. The HSEY for students who enter the 9<sup>th</sup> grade or higher for the first time after March 13, 2020 may be appealed for students repeating their grade for the 2020-21 school year.

Find additional information in the <u>HSEY Guidance</u>. Once a HSEY has been entered into the SSID for a student, it may only be changed by completing a <u>High School Entry Year Correction Template</u>, which is sent to your <u>Regional ESD Partner</u>.
