### **OSAS Webinar: Effectively Using 2022 - 23 Summative Assessment Data to Inform Continuous Improvement**

As the OSAS test window closes on June 2, 2023, ODE is hosting its final webinar to support district and building leaders in the interpretation of summative assessment data. These data are a vital component of a district's or school's continuous improvement planning, and ODE's goal is to share new and existing resources within the [OSAS Portal](#).

The webinar will explore how the OSAS tests can provide several layers of data that can be monitored over time and across student groups. While students' overall OSAS test scores provide a high-level glimpse at grade-level achievement, participants will deepen their understanding of how OSAS test design and trends in target data can inform the evaluation of systems of teaching and learning.

Additionally, ODE is excited to demonstrate a **NEW** multi-year cross-sectional report within the Reporting System that displays up to a three-year trend of target-level data. This automates the creation of "target trend reports" that ODE has been promoting since 2019.

Attendees will receive an overview of an existing tool - the [Smarter Content Explorer](#) - as well as explore the connections between the OSAS test results, assessment targets, standards, achievement level descriptors, and more.

### **Parent Opt-Out and Impact on Participation & Performance Announcement**

- **The Why**
  - [ORS 329.479: Student Assessment Bill of Rights](#) give parents the ability to opt their children out of participating in the statewide summative assessment.

- Participation includes reporting, as well, for example, in the case where a student has been accidentally tested.
- **The Changes:** The Assessment Inclusions Rules Manual was updated and posted on June 2nd with the following information:
  - a) Cases where students tested in ELA or Math even though there was a signed Opt-out form on file shall be reported as testing improprieties via the usual Test Impropriety Reporting System, and any tests started will be invalidated in Cambium’s system.
  - b) Test records with an Administration Code of X and enough item responses to meet the threshold for participation will be invalidated.
- **When:** The changes go into effect for this 22-23 school year and will remain in effect for future years.

## Official Individual Student Report Reminder

ODE provides ISRs for ELA, Math, Science, and ELPA statewide summative tests to schools and districts via the [Secure Assessment Reports 2.0](#) application. The official ISRs are currently available in English and Spanish and are ADA compliant. In addition, parents or guardians may request from schools and districts a written or oral translation of the ISR in their respective language or a language they understand. If districts choose to produce and provide an ISR to parents or guardians in lieu of using ODE’s ISR, the district ISR must meet the same federal and state requirements as ODE’s ISR (i.e., timeliness, content, format accessibility, and language translation). ## 2023-24 District Test Coordinator and Information Only Designation Contact Form **REPEAT**

ODE requires that districts annually designate a District Test Coordinator (DTC) using the District Test Coordinator Designation Form. District Test Coordinators who wish to edit records for students who took an OSAS Extended Assessment in 2022-23 may select the Test Type “Extended Assessments” when searching for records in the Assessment Transactional System. Be sure to resolve errors before downloading or reviewing records online so that the data is as accurate as possible.
