New Dyslexia Legislation Passed by the 2017 Legislature

Senate Bill (SB) 1003, passed by the 2017 legislature, was signed by Governor Kate Brown on June 22, 2017. The bill carries forward the dyslexia-related training requirements from SB 612, extending the deadline for completion of the training and includes requirements for districts to universally screen for risk factors of dyslexia in kindergarten.

Training Requirements:

SB 1003 has extended the deadline for teachers to complete the required dyslexia-related training to July 1, 2018.

Screening Requirements:

The legislation requires that:

- Each school district ensure that every student is screened for risk factors of dyslexia using a screening test identified by the department when the student is first enrolled in a public school in kindergarten (or first grade, if a student is first enrolled in public school for first grade).
- The screening tests administered to students in kindergarten must include phonological awareness, rapid naming skills, and letter/sound correspondences.
- The screening must take into account family history of difficulty in learning to read IF the student shows risk factors for reading difficulties, including dyslexia.

The screening requirements first apply to the 2018-19 school year. For additional information on SB 1003, please view our <u>webpage</u>.

Class Roster Collection - Important Dates

The Class Roster Collection will close at 11:59 PM tomorrow, **Friday**, **June 30**. It will remain closed until the afternoon on **Thursday**, **July 6**, when it will reopen for the audit review window through **Friday**, **July 14**. Every district/school should submit their data before the initial window closes on June 30 to ensure that their data will be validated through ODE's audit process, as there is only one round of audits with this collection. Every district/school should log back into consolidated collections during the audit review window to review their audits.

These data are being used to populate the <u>Class Size report</u> and will be published on the <u>School/District Report Cards</u> page. To ensure accurate reporting of these data, please review your Class Size Validation after you have fixed your audits. The Class Size Validation will open in the <u>Achievement Data Insight (ADI) application</u> on the afternoon of **Thursday**, **July 6** and remain open through **Friday**, **September 15**. Please log into the <u>Class Size Validation and Class Roster Audit Webinar</u> on Thursday, July 6 at 2 PM to learn more about this process. The training will be recorded and posted <u>online</u> a few days after the training date.

Smarter Balanced Partials

Smarter Balanced ELA and Math partial test records (any test where the student completed at least one item, but never finished the test) will be available on Friday, July 7 in the Student Centered Staging, Accountability Warehouse Extract (AWE) and Secure Assessment Reports 2.0 applications. If you do not have access to these applications, please contact your <u>district security administrator</u>.

Partials with no scores

• Records where the student completed at least five CAT items OR one PT item, but not both, have no scores, and performance level 1 for the total test and all claims.

Partials with scores

Records where the student completed at least five CAT items AND one PT item have scores and
performance levels for the total test, and if all CAT items were answered, scores and performance
levels for the claims.

Be sure to resolve errors in Student Centered Staging before downloading or reviewing reports online so that the data is as accurate as possible. Please contact your <u>Regional ESD Partner</u> for more information or for assistance accessing these records.

English Learners Student Group on the Report Card Detail Sheets

The following codes are used on assessment records to indicate students' English Learners (EL) Program status for use in accountability reporting:

Code	Definition
Blank	Not an EL student
A	An EL student enrolled for less than 1 year in U.S. school, without ELPA21
В	An EL student enrolled for less than 1 year in U.S. school, with ELPA21
Е	An EL student enrolled for more than 5 years in a U.S. school
F {New!}	(Former) A student proficient in English exited from an EL program three or four years ago
M {New!}	(Monitored, year 1) A student proficient in English exited from an EL program in the prior year
N	(Not EL) A student submitted in the EL Collection not meeting criteria for the student group
S {New!}	(Monitored, year 2) A student proficient in English exited from an EL program two years ago
W	A student exited from an EL program on or prior to May 1 of the current school year
X	A student exited from an EL program after May 1 of the current school year
Y	An EL student enrolled for 2 to 5 years in a U.S. school

On the school and district Report Card Detail sheets, students who have been exited from an EL Program in the current year are included as part of the EL student group for up to two years after they have demonstrated proficiency on the ELPA21 or are otherwise exited from an EL program by the district.
