## **Reminder: Annual DTC Training Requirements**

As a reminder, District Test Coordinators (DTCs) must participate in the annual test security and administration training provided by ODE. *DTCs* who do <u>not</u> participate in annual test security and administration training will have their current access to the OSAS system revoked and may not receive important updates sent to the DTC listserv. For 2018-19, DTCs must:

- Independently review the 2018-19 ODE-provided recorded <u>training modules</u> (to be posted by **October 1, 2018**) between October 1 and November 2, 2018;
- 2. Complete the ODE-provided training survey (to be posted by **October 1, 2018**) by November 2, 2018; and
- Register for one of the required ODE-facilitated Webinar sessions listed in Section 1.5 of the <u>Preliminary Test</u> Administration Manual.

In addition, DTCs and District Level Users (DLUs) have the following reading requirements:

- Sections 1 14 and Appendices A F of the <u>Test</u>
   <u>Administration Manual</u> (the Final 2018-19 Test

   Administration manual will be posted by **October 1, 2018**)
- The <u>Oregon Accessibility Manual</u> (see OAM for role-specific reading requirements)
- The Essential Skills and Local Performance Assessment Manual

## Handling Improprieties on the ELPA Screener

The purpose of ELP screening is to give districts valid and reliable data to support district decisions about identifying students as eligible for ELD services. If an impropriety occurs that the district believes affects the validity of screening results, the district should issue the student a new Temporary ID and retest the student. Given the short screening timeline,

and consistent with past screener administration practices, decisions around improprieties will remain at the district level. Districts must report any breaches of test security to ode.testsecurity@state.or.us.
