#### **ESSENTIAL SKILLS**

#### **Updated Official Writing Scoring Guide**

Starting with the 2017-2018 school year, the updated Official Writing Scoring Guide aligned to the Oregon Common Core State Standards is the only scoring guide approved to score work samples for demonstrating proficiency in the Essential Skill of writing.

Note - There are two versions of the updated Official Writing Scoring Guide:

- Narrative writing (personal or fictional)
- Informative, Explanatory, Argumentative, and Research writing

ODE recommends that the Official Writing Scoring Guide be used as a teaching and assessment tool across content areas, and at all grade levels. ODE also recommends that the Official Writing Scoring Guide be used in 3-8 classrooms to score work samples for fulfilling the <a href="Local Performance">Local Performance</a> <a href="Assessment">Assessment</a> requirement, as well as other writing assessments.
