ODE requires that all DTCs register for one of these scheduled ODE-facilitated Webinar sessions by **October 12, 2018** using the <u>GoToWebinar link</u>. DTCs who are unable to participate in one of these ODE-facilitated WebEx sessions must notify their <u>Regional ESD Partner</u> by **November 1, 2018**.

Dyslexia Screening Requirements Update

Senate Bill 1003 requires that beginning in the 2018-19 school year, districts screen all kindergarten students for risk factors of dyslexia (and any first grade student who first enrolls in public school in Oregon for first grade) using a screening test identified by the Oregon Department of Education. The Department has developed a FINAL list of approved screening tools for the 2018-19 school year.

All kindergartners must be screened in phonological awareness, letter/sound correspondence and rapid naming and in accordance with the test developers' guidelines. For more information, see the full Dyslexia Screening Requirements update.

Last Day to Make Edits to the Class Roster Collection: September 14

The last day to make changes to your Class Roster Collection will be Friday, September 14; the collection cannot be reopened after this date. If you haven't already done so, please review your Class Size Validation by logging into <u>Central</u> Log In and selecting the Achievement Data Insight application to access your validation data.

Class Size data are published now on the front of the At-A-Glance school report cards and will be published in a <u>standalone report</u> later in October. Answers to Common Questions from the Field

QUESTION: When is the public release of the 2017-18 assessment results?

ANSWER: The Oregon Department of Education (ODE) will publicly release the 2017-18 state assessment results on **Thursday, September 20, 2018**. These results will be available on an embargoed basis to districts and members of the media starting the afternoon of **Tuesday, September 18, 2018**.
