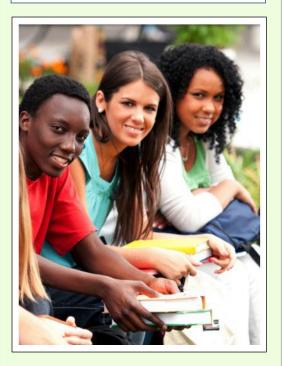

# **Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE) Webinars**

AIR redesigned TIDE in order to reduce the amount of time it takes users to complete their most critical tasks, offer a more visually pleasing user interface, make the design responsive to different devices that users may be using, and improve system performance based on a wider range of tasks. The redesigned TIDE opens for the 2016-17 school year on **Thursday**, **October 27**. To support users in transitioning to the new TIDE, the Oregon Department of Education and the American Institutes for Research (AIR) have scheduled two **optional** webinars focusing on how to use the newly-redesigned Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE):

- Tuesday, November 15 from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. PT
- Thursday, November 17 from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. PT

# **ELPA21 Screener Project Update**

For the past two years, the ELPA21 consortium of states has been working on the design and implementation of a new screener that will replace the commercial assessments used for initial identification of potential English Learners (ELs) who arrive in our K-12 schools. This project is part of the original Enhanced Assessment Grant awarded to the ELPA21 consortium. Currently, a vendor for the design and piloting of the ELPA21 screener is being chosen through a formal process. Once a vendor is officially engaged with the project, there will be recruitment for school districts in the ELPA21 states to help pilot the screener in preparation for final design decisions. Operational use of the ELPA21 screener will begin in Oregon in the 2017-18 school year. Until the ELPA21 screener is finalized and ready for use next year, school district staff should continue to screen potential ELs using the commercial screeners that are on Oregon's approved initial identification assessments list as noted in the <u>EL Program Guide</u>.

# **ELPA21 Test Specifications Documents Are Posted**

The first draft of the 2016-17 ELPA21 Test Specifications and Blueprints documents have been posted for the six ELPA21 grade bands. These documents should be considered preliminary, as there are a number of decisions that are still in process for this year's operational administration of the assessment. There are notes in each section of the document where decision-making is not yet finalized. The preliminary documents can be found <u>here</u>, and will be updated when new information is finalized regarding ELPA21 in 2016-17.

# Fall Alignment Study

We are hoping to select special education teachers who have had at least five years of experience working with Students With Significant Cognitive Disabilities (SWSCD) *and* general education teachers who have had five years of teaching experience.

Training will be provided **Wednesday**, **November 16**, **2016** (3:30 - 5:00 PM) with a plan for participants to have completed all reviews by **December 16**, **2016**. Both the training and the study/review are webbased so educators can participate at times and places most convenient for them.
