The 2016-17 30-day notice and opt-out form are now posted to ODE's webpage along with the 2016-17 annual notice at <a href="http://www.ode.state.or.us/search/page/?id=4302">http://www.ode.state.or.us/search/page/?id=4302</a>. Districts are required to distribute the Annual Notice to parents at the start of each school year and must also distribute the combined 30-day notice and opt-out form by January 7, 2017.

# **Reporting Test Improprieties**

New for 2016-17, DTCs will submit their initial report electronically using an online form that will be posted to <a href="http://www.ode.state.or.us/go/TestSecurity">http://www.ode.state.or.us/go/TestSecurity</a> by October 1, 2016. ODE will also post a step-by-step guide and how-to video to assist DTCs with using the new online form and submission process.

For the 2016 Kindergarten Assessment test window, until the new online form is available, districts should continue to follow the reporting procedures described in Section 3.6 of the <u>Preliminary 2016-17 Test Administration</u> using the report form included in Appendix K: Test Impropriety Initial Report Form.

#### **Question & Answer**

ANSWERS TO COMMON QUESTIONS FROM THE FIELD

**Question:** When do you use Administration Code 'E' (Eligible Student not Tested in Spanish) for the Kindergarten Assessment Early Math Collection?

**Answer:** To use 'E' (Eligible Student not Tested in Spanish) in the Early Math collection, without the record producing an error, the student must be *Officially Identified Spanish-speaking English Learner*, and needs to meet the following conditions:

- ✓ LEPFg= Y
- ✓ Language of Origin= 4260
- ✓ Attempt Code= Y or N
- ✓ Admin Code= E

Two Examples for when you would use Admin Code 'E' (Eligible Student not Tested in Spanish) without producing an error:

- 1. If an officially identified Spanish-speaking English Learner <u>was given the English Only version</u> when they should have received the Bilingual version (Attempt 'Y')
  - o Attempt Code= Y
  - o LEPfg=Y
  - o Lang Of Origin= 4260
  - o Tested via Bilingual Version (SpnLngFg)= N Will not produce an error, however if the student receives the incorrect version of this assessment, this is considered a testing impropriety and must be reported by the District Test Coordinator as a test impropriety
- **2.** If an officially identified Spanish-speaking English Learner <u>was not given the opportunity to take</u> the Bilingual version of the Early Math assessment (Attempt 'N')
  - o Attempt Code= N
  - o LEPfg=Y
  - o Lang Of Origin= 4260
  - o Tested via Bilingual Version (SpnLngFg)= N Will not produce an error, and will be considered a non-participant
