# Warning message when creating multiple Temp IDs for same student

If you need to create a second Temp ID for students taking the ELPA Screener assessment, you will receive the "Student Existed Warning" message. This message alerts you that the student already has a Temp ID, and it does not prevent you from creating the new Temp ID. You are able to move ahead with creating the Temp ID by clicking the Continue button. You will then proceed to the "Add Student" confirmation message.

# 17-18 Report Card Narrative Data Collection Closes September 28

The Report Card Narrative Data Collection will close on **September 28, 2018**. The Report Card Narrative Data Collection is located within the <u>Achievement Data Insight (ADI)</u> application. If you do not have access, please contact your <u>District Security Administrator</u>.

The collection allows you to save your work in progress and come back to it later. Narratives must be submitted, not just saved, before ODE will publish them. You will see a row of green checkmarks on the maintenance page when the narrative for an institution has been successfully submitted. ODE strongly recommends previewing your submission in both English and Spanish before submission.
