The Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE) will be offline from **Friday, October 18 at 5 p.m. PT to Sunday, October 20 at 7 p.m. PT** to deploy new features and fix existing bugs. A list of the new features will be posted on the <u>OSAS Portal</u> on Monday, October 7.

The new <u>Smarter Content Explorer</u> website is now available. With the Smarter Content Explorer, educators can:

- support instruction by better understanding the ELA and Math claims and targets at each grade level,
- find evidence statements for each target and standard,
- interact with sample items and task models to help plan activities aligned to grade-level claims and targets,
- explore the range of knowledge and skills for college and career readiness, and
- learn about test development with resources like blueprints and scoring rubrics.

Coming Soon: 2019-20 DTC Training Materials

By close of business **Friday, September 27** ODE will post the following annual test security and administration training materials for District Test Coordinators (DTCs) to access:

Reminder: 2019-20 Oregon 1% Cap Reporting Requirements
