### Coming Soon: 2017-18 DTC Training Materials

By close of business tomorrow, Friday, September 29, ODE will post the following annual test security and administration training materials for District Test Coordinators (DTCs) to access:

### Panelists Needed: Kindergarten Assessment Advisory Panel

ODE is recruiting for the Kindergarten Assessment Advisory Panel. This panel will help ODE with future Kindergarten Assessments and help to develop resources for stakeholders. ODE is looking for experienced Kindergarten Teachers and Early Learning Providers who are familiar with Oregon's Kindergarten Assessment and Oregon's Early Learning and Kindergarten Standards. **KA teachers, Early Learning Providers, and Specialists from all regions of Oregon are encouraged to apply.** **Applicants will be selected based on their experience and representation**

**of socio-economic status, English learner status, and all diverse populations.** In addition, some members of previous ODE Kindergarten panels will be identified for historical continuity.

The first meeting of the 2017-18 KA Advisory Panel is scheduled for **December 7** in Salem. There is a possibility of additional work days which will be scheduled as the events are finalized. Generally, panel members can expect to meet up to 5 school days during each school year. Appointments to the KA advisory panel have a duration of 3 school years. ## ESSENTIAL SKILLS

### Updated Official Writing Scoring Guide

Starting with the 2017-2018 school year, the updated [Official Writing Scoring Guide](#) aligned to the Oregon Common Core State Standards is the only scoring guide approved to score work samples for demonstrating proficiency in the [Essential Skill of writing](#).

Note - There are two versions of the updated Official Writing Scoring Guide:

- Narrative writing (personal or fictional)
- Informative, Explanatory, Argumentative, and Research writing

ODE recommends that the Official Writing Scoring Guide be used as a teaching and assessment tool across content areas, and at all grade levels. ODE also recommends that the Official Writing Scoring Guide be used in 3-8 classrooms to score work samples for fulfilling the [Local Performance Assessment](#) requirement, as well as other writing assessments. ### REMINDER: Accountability Reports Remain Embargoed

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

### Answers to Common Questions from the Field

**QUESTION:** When will TIDE be updated with current student information for 2017-18?

**ANSWER:** When the 2017-18 TIDE launches on November 7, 2017, it will be updated with the current resident students in each district. At that point, as student information is updated in ODE's SSID collection, it will be updated in TIDE within 48 hours.
