Oregon Extended Assessment 1% Participation Cap Projections REPEAT

Given the limited participation experienced in the spring of 2021, districts are not required to submit new projections for the 1% Participation Cap for the 2021-22 school year.

ODE plans to carry fall 2019 projections forward unless your district is expecting student demographic shifts in the coming year. If you foresee that district participation rates on the Oregon Extended Assessment will differ substantially from what was previously reported for your district in 2019, or that information submitted during that reporting period may be inaccurate, please complete a new <u>Justification Form</u> for 2021-22.

Oregon ELA Assessment Blueprint for 2021-22 REPEAT

The Oregon Department of Education (ODE) has published the <u>2021-22 Oregon Summative Assessment of English Language Arts Blueprint</u>. The blueprint table identifies how many stimuli and items students will see on the 2021-22 Oregon ELA Summative Assessment for each of the claims: Reading, Writing, Listening, and Research. ODE will publish and communicate an updated version of the 2021-22 Oregon ELA Summative Assessment blueprint in mid to late October 2021. The updated Oregon ELA blueprint document will include the number of items for each assessment target and the number of depth of knowledge items.

Additionally, ODE has created a 2021-22 ELA Blueprint Summary of Changes document. This document provides an Overview of Changes Table for both the Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) and the Performance Task (PT) portions of the 2021-22 Oregon ELA Summative Assessment BP as compared to the previous 2019-20 OSAS ELA BP. The document also provides a Summary of Changes section which provides a more detailed explanation of changes occurring within each claim as compared to the previous 2019-20 OSAS ELA BP.
