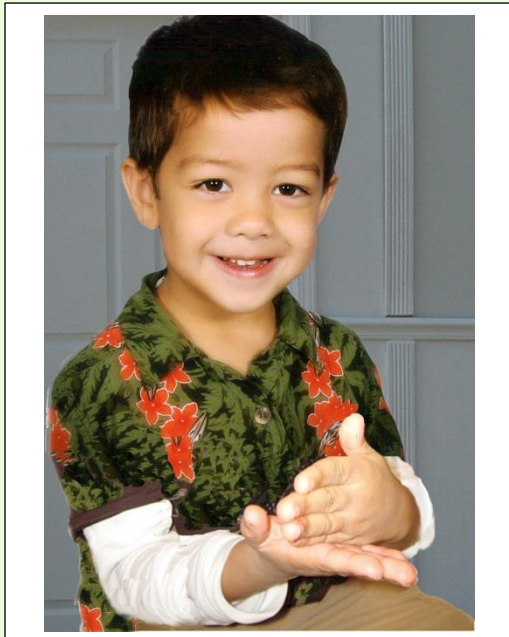

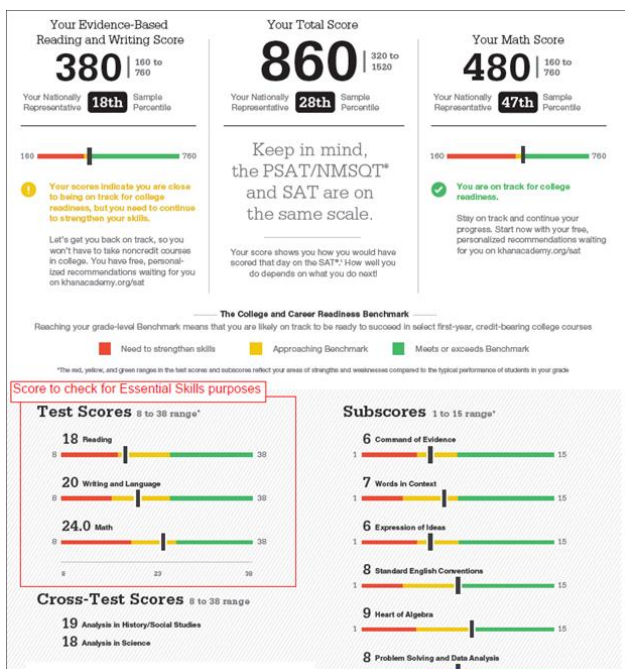
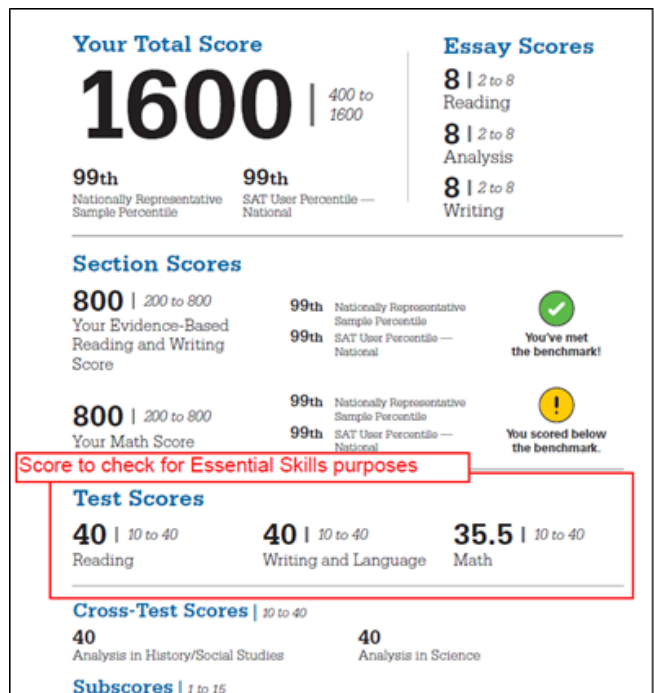

Question & Answer

ANSWERS TO COMMON QUESTIONS FROM THE FIELD

Question: In the *Other Standardized Assessment Achievement Standards for Essential Skills* table in the Essential Skills and Local Performance Assessment Manual, the SAT option lists a score of a 24, 27, and 24.5 to demonstrate Essential Skills in Reading, Writing, and Math, respectively. However, the new SAT is still scored on a scale of 0-800. Can you please provide me with some information as to how to interpret whether a SAT score after 3/2016 meets the Essential Skill requirement?

Answer: Regarding Reading, Writing, and Math Essential Skills, look at the Reading, Writing and Language, and Math *Test Scores*, respectively. The 800 point scales are the *Total Scores*, which are different and not approved. An example student score report is included on the right to show the *Test Scores*.



Question: In the *Other Standardized Assessment Achievement Standards for Essential Skills* table in the Essential Skills and Local Performance Assessment Manual, the PSAT option lists a score of a 24 and 24.5 to demonstrate Essential Skills in Reading and Math, respectively. However, the new PSAT scores I see are on a much larger scale. Can you please provide me with some information as to how to interpret whether a PSAT score from 10/2015 or later meets the Essential Skill requirement?

Answer: Regarding Math and Reading Essential Skills, look at the *Test Scores* for all of them. The larger scales are the *Total Scores*, which are different and not approved. An example student score report is included on the left to show the *Test Scores*.
