Answers to Common Questions from the Field

QUESTION: What policy document should I be referring to for accessibility supports for statewide assessments?

ANSWER: The official manual for accessibility supports is the <u>Oregon</u> <u>Accessibility Manual</u>. No other policy documentation should be referenced for Oregon's statewide assessment system unless explicitly stated in <u>Oregon's Test Administration Manual</u> or the <u>Oregon Accessibility Manual</u>.
