# **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

#### **Answers to Common Questions from the Field**

QUESTION: If our students are enrolled for the entire reporting period in Cumulative ADM, what end date do we use?

**ANSWER:** The End Date for all Cumulative ADM Reporting Periods should be the first weekday *after* the last date of enrollment. For First Period Cumulative ADM, if your students are enrolled through October 1, 2018 the End Date should be October 2, 2018. If the End Date of October 1, 2018 is used in error, your students will not show up on the Fall Membership report.
