**Q1: When a teacher rosters classes, is it a grade band (all grade 3) or a teacher by teacher roster (Teacher A - 3; Teacher B - 3)?**

A: It can be done either way. Rosters can be made up of students across teachers and across grades (if desired).

**Q2: Do rosters have to be created before testing?**

A: No, rosters do not need to be created before testing. They can be created at any time during the school year.

**Q3: Are the Individual Student Reports (ISRs) translated into the student's home language?**

A: At this time, only ELPA Screener and ELPA Summative ISRs are translated in CRS. They are available in both English and Spanish.

**Q4: Can I see previous scores/reports for students that were not mine last year but are mine this year?**

A: Yes, you can see previous scores for students who are yours currently, but who were not yours in previous years when they tested. In the Features & Tools menu, select "Change Reporting Time Period." Select the school year for which you want to review results.

**Q5: Is there a way to look at a cohort of students over multiple years?**

A: Yes. First, roster those students. Then, run a longitudinal report on that roster.

**Q6: Where can I locate a longitudinal report?**

A: In the Features & Tools menu, select "Build Longitudinal Reports." The Longitudinal Report button appears.



**Q7: Who creates rosters for a school?**

A: Anyone can create rosters, even a TA.

**Q8: Do students need to be rostered in order for teachers to see scores?**

A: No, you can see results even if students are not rostered.
