Updates and Reminders

- The <u>test windows</u> for Science (general and extended), Remote ELPA Summative,
 24-25 Future K Screener, and Alt-SEED / SEED Survey are now open.
- Students who will be testing remotely must have the Remote Tester button set to "yes" and the Parent Consent for A/V Monitoring must be selected. Contact your <u>Regional ESD Partner</u> for assistance uploading the remote test settings into TIDE.
- The PreACT order window closes 3/21.
- <u>ELTC Listening Session Opportunities</u> with Oregon's Kitchen Table for early learning partners and culturally specific groups (<u>Spanish registration</u>)

More Updates and Reminders

- ELPA Summative batch 1 available 3/12. Scoring for Honoring Student Proficiency on the HS ELPA Summative will complete 3/19.
- ELPA Screener: remember that the feature "Update Temp ID to SSID" can be used to associate Screener results with a student's profile in TIDE and make them easier to locate in the future.
- Provisionally Proficient feedback gathered at COSA Multilingual and English Learner conference (March 7) and Title III office hours (March 11); will help inform final approval decision

Question 1: CRS Score Reports

Q: Exported ELPA files from CRS show "exempted" for domains that a high school student showed proficiency in a prior year, as well as for students who have IEP-mandated domain exemptions. Could Cambium use a different label for the HS Proficiency ones?

A: Cambium indicates that it is not possible to change this label as the system is currently configured. ODE will investigate if this is possible for future years.

Note that with the sole exception of the ELPA Screener, score reports found in CRS are unofficial. ODE data applications are the source for all official summative score reports.

Score reports in CRS for students participating in <u>Honoring Student Proficiency on the HS ELPA Summative</u> have not yet completed scoring and do not reflect carried domains.

Test Impropriety Submissions

Errors in test impropriety reports increase the chance that changes will be made to the wrong test record.

- Please double check SSID and Result ID
 - You can find the Result ID in TIDE: Monitoring Test Progress → Participation
 Search by SSID
- If supports or accommodations should have been provided but were not, please indicate which one(s).
- If there is an issue with the testing platform, please contact the <u>OSAS Helpdesk</u> before submitting an impropriety.

Test Impropriety Submissions, Continued

- A DTC who is sick or absent may need someone to submit a testing impropriety on their behalf. Please make sure this person understands all elements of the form.
 - To confirm that district personnel are acting with the DTC's knowledge and authorization, please enter both names in the DTC Name field: [alternate submitter's name], on behalf of [DTC name]
 - To make sure someone from the district can respond in a timely fashion, enter the DTC's email and the alternate submitter's email in the DTC Email field: [DTC email]; [alternate submitter's email]
- Reminder: test improprieties remain a primary responsibility of the DTC.

DTC Investigation and Reports

A thorough investigation and report will result in faster resolution

Student stood up and walked to his phone where TA had it stored and began texting. He was away from his test when he was texting since his phone was on the opposite side of the room and when TA turned her back for a quick second to grab a piece of paper he quietly walked over and picked up his phone.

Fortunately, he was the only student in the room and TA stopped the test session immediately. TA checked his phone and confirmed that he was texting his mom to come pick him up from school and was not using the phone to check the answers. TA then called parents to double check and it was also confirmed.

A less detailed report will take longer to resolve, as ODE will need to reach out for more information

Student had a cell phone.

When thinking about the district's recommended action:

- Did or will the student receive an unfair advantage or disadvantage?
- Is or will there be a test security issue?
- Is there potential harm, trauma, or undue hardship for the student?

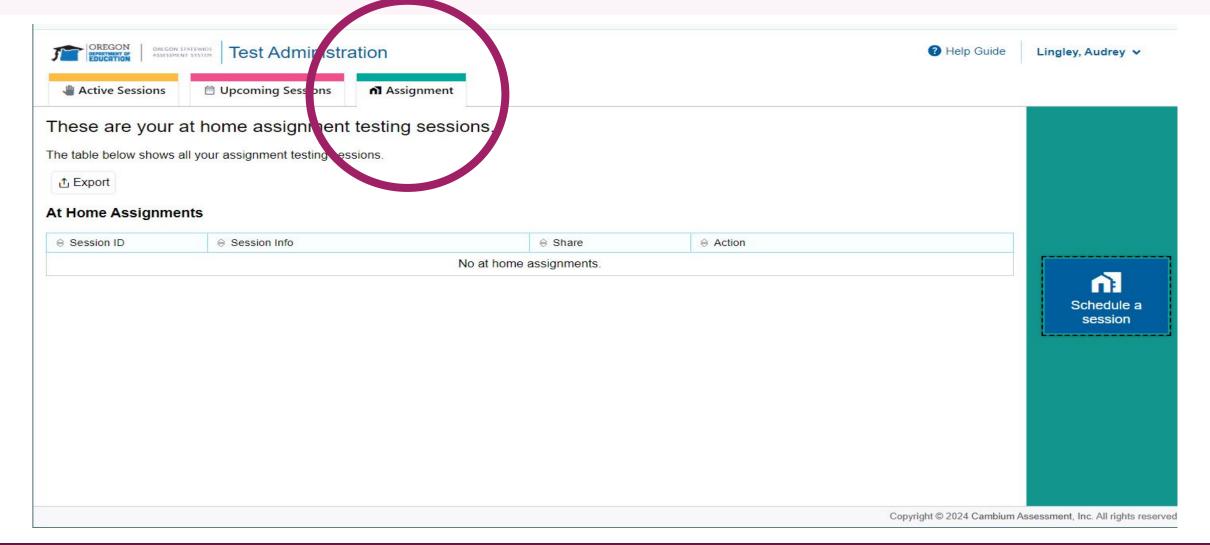

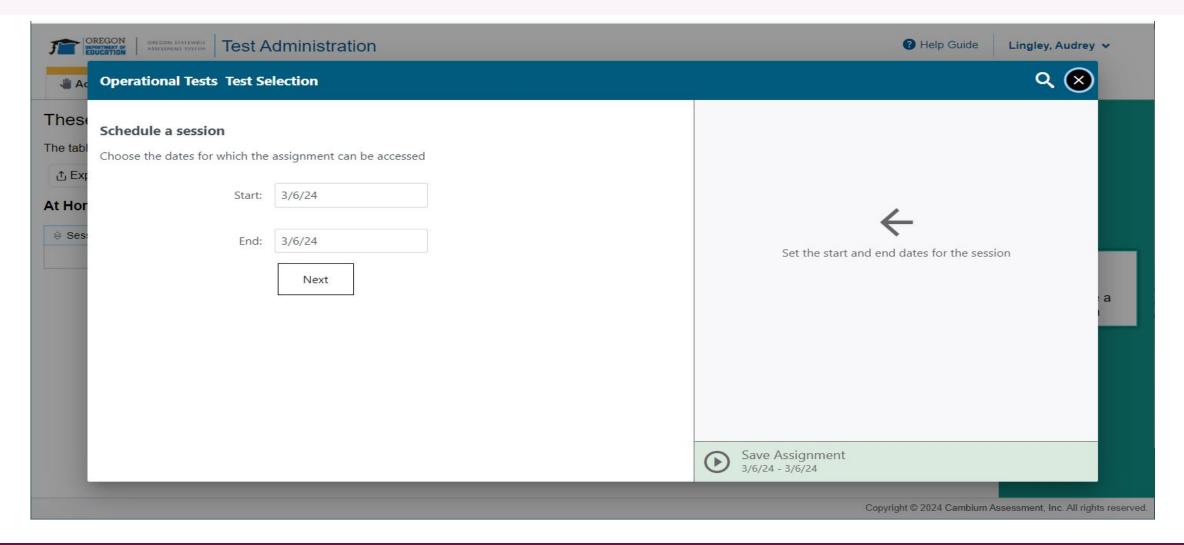

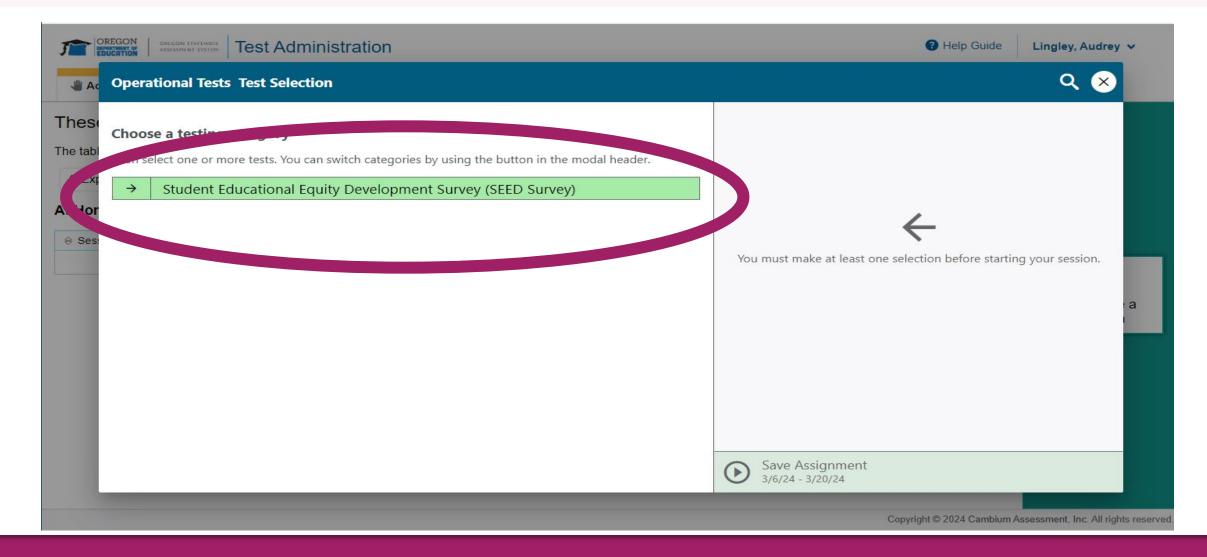
SEED Survey: Delivery Format

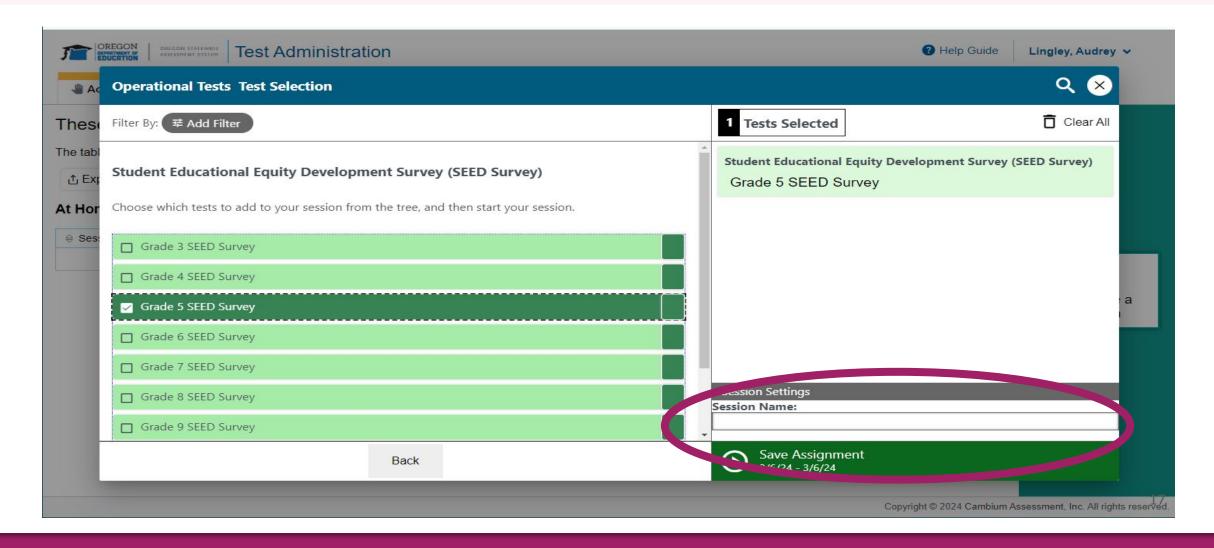
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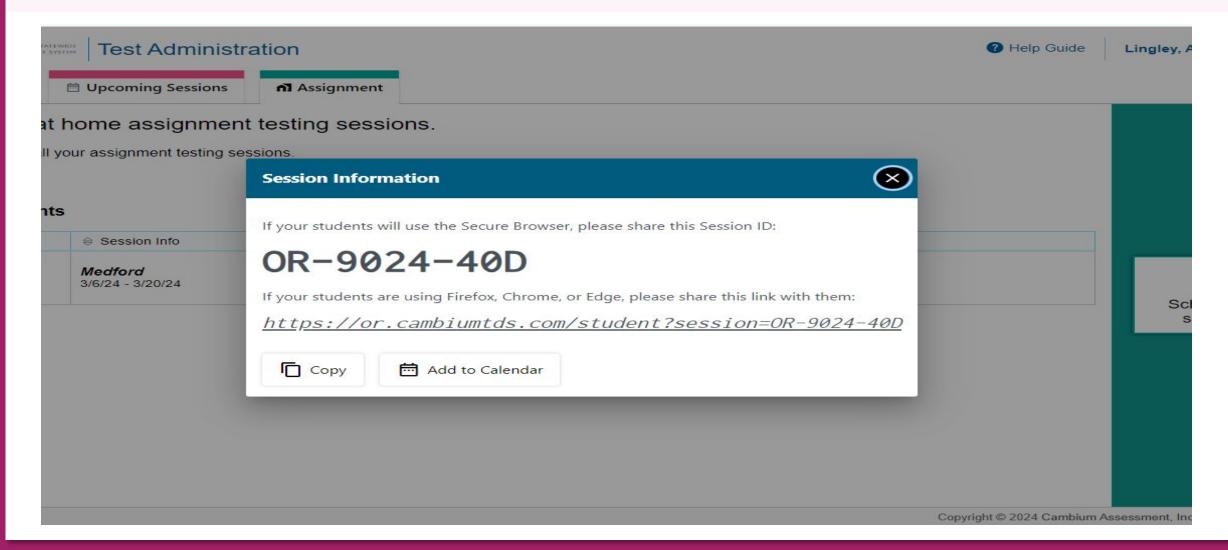
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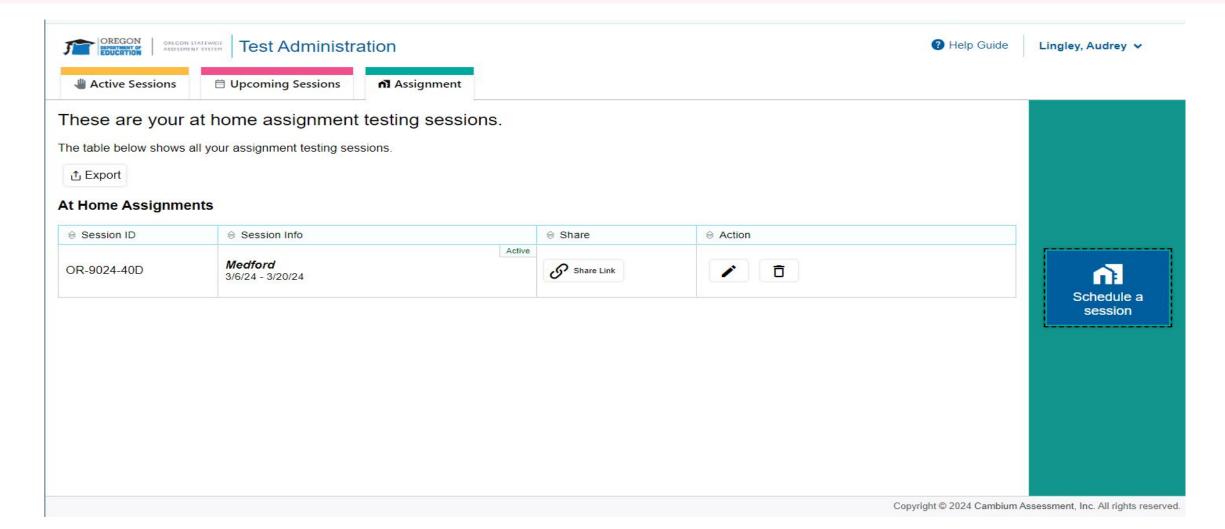












Clarifying HS Testing Requirement

OSAS statewide summative tests are still required for students enrolled in grades 3 - 8 and high school as described in ESEA, Title I Part A, sec. 1111(b)(3), ORS 329.485, and OAR 581-022-2100 (Division 22).

HS students still test. The score does not currently impact graduation.
