

## Informal DTC Webinar: Q&A Session – June 13, 2018

### General Questions

Q: When will partials for ELA and Math be available?

- Partials for ELA and Math will be available by July 6.

Q: When will Virtual Records be loaded?

- Virtual records are already available. Folks should contact their Regional ESD Partner for assistance.

Q: Can you remind me where I order KG Assessments?

- You can order them online through TIDE

Q: Do you know when the new percentile rank tables for 17-18 testing will be available?

- Percentile rank tables for 2017-18 will be posted the week of September 10-14, 2018.

Q: How do we order the paper tests for ELPA21 Screener for Kg & 1st grades?

- Oregon offers NO paper and pencil ELPA21 Screener tests EXCEPT for the Braille version. It is all online administration for Oregon.

Q: Does this mean that we do not need to mark ELPA and science parent exemptions with an admin. code of X?

- The administration code X applies only to ELA and Math and is not allowed for ELPA or Science.

Q: To double-check, code 7 (Parent Request) is no longer an option? So if a parent said they wanted to exempt their students from ELPA21 based on religion, would we use that?

- ELPA falls under the guidance for [OAR 581-022-1910](#), which applies to all “state required learning activities.” The same code for parent-requested exemption that is used for disability or religion for science, social sciences, and KA would be applicable. Math and ELA have the separate opt-out code X.

Q: Should we contact you if there is a principal change?

- If there is a principal change, and you notify the ODE Institutions Database Coordinator, I will have the necessary information. If you would like to copy me when you send the information to ODE that is great but not necessary.

Q: What is the correct timeline for recording a principal change? Should that occur before or after the 2017-18 School Report Cards are published?

- When you submit the information, you need to send the date that the change is effective, along with the name, telephone number, and email address.
