Assessment Participation and Reporting

- Student participation in Oregon's state summative assessments remains a requirement in federal law - 95% for all students and every student group (ESSA, Section 1111)
- Division 22 requires districts to make state summative assessment participation available to all students
- ODE developed a <u>communication toolkit</u> to support districts in explaining how to best leverage the resources in our balanced assessment system, which can only happen with sufficient participation.
- Reporting processes will include references to strength areas, as one aspect of our system that is important is to identify possible models of success to replicate

- Test Window: 10/2/2023 4/9/2024
- Order window opened 9/11 for DTCs to order materials through the <u>College and Career Readiness Information System (CCRIS)</u> by selecting the OREGON GRADE 10 ONLY option. The window for ordering materials closes on March 21, 2024.

Remembering the why - to create inclusive and safe environments for all students in all aspects of their educational experience, including the testing process


Things to be aware of...


- Last name must exactly match what is present in TIDE, including suffixes and special characters.
- For students who share the same last name or similar SSIDs, additional attention will be needed to ensure the correct SSID is used (ex. "last four digits").
- It may be useful to consult Student Logins with Uncommon Characters



SEED Survey and HB 2656

- House Bill 2656 was signed in July by Governor Kotek.
- District are required to make the SEED Survey available to students in grades 3-11 during the testing window.
- SEED Survey Quick Guide will become the SEED Survey Administration Manual.
 - Publish by end of October with an accompanying webinar
- For now, ensure the SEED Survey is included in your district's testing schedule.
- If you are interested in participating in an engagement group, email Mason Rivers, Special Education Assessment Specialist, by the end of the week.

Reminder: District Assessment Inventory

- <u>HB 4124</u> requires districts to complete an inventory of academic assessments administered by Oregon school districts ("District Assessment Inventory")
 - Legislative requirement
 - Inventory to be completed in 2023-24 school year; legislative report due May 2024
- Design finalized, tool now in creation
- DTC will be the point of contact between ODE and districts
 - DTC is not individually responsible for completing the District Assessment Inventory; districts may locally decide who works on the Inventory
- To plan ahead, consider starting a list of all *academic* assessments delivered in your district, and how many students participate in each
- Future updates will include more detail

OSAS Math Test Updates & Changes

- Spanish/ English language toggle is here!
- Transitional Grade 11 Math CAT blueprint in 2023-24 → coming October 2!
 - Four assessment targets eliminated via 2021 Oregon Math Standards
 - Reduced item pool
 - Rebalanced items across targets
- No changes to Grade 11 Math PT
- Sample Grade 11 Math CAT updated when sample tests refresh (31 October)
- No changes to HS interims
- No changes to scoring or reporting
- No changes to Grade 3-8 OSAS Math Test blueprints
