

## Update

- ELPA windows
  - ELPA Summative and Grade K Screener opened on 1/9/24
  - Alt ELPA will open 1/30/24
  - Remote ELPA window opens March 3/5/24
- For tests in 2024 and following, remember to log in using last name
- If your district has not yet received access to a District Assessment Inventory form, you (the DTC) probably need to <u>designate a point of</u> <u>contact</u>

## Technical Issue Update

Issue impacting access to Spanish TTS on Chromebooks running Chrome OS version 119+.

#### What is the issue:

- Google removed support for embedded es-mx Spanish voice pack, which CAI uses for Spanish TTS.
- Spanish TTS does not currently work on Chromebooks using the most recent Chrome OS (version 119+).

#### Who does this impact:

- Tests currently impacted: interims and sample tests
- Chromebook users whose devices have auto-updated to Chrome OS version 119+.

## Technical Issue Update (cont'd)

#### **How** is the issue being addressed:

- Cambium (CAI) is actively working with Google and is being treated as high priority.
- CAI deployed a temporary workaround that will allow users to continue to use Spanish TTS on Interims taken on Chromebooks (any Chrome OS version) using the Chrome web browser, and in the Sample tests when accessed on a Chromebook (any Chrome OS version) as a Guest user in the Chrome web browser.
- CAI Helpdesk and ESD Partners are aware of this issue and can assist any users who call in.
- Cambium continues sharing the reminder to consider blocking auto-updates during the testing season to help avoid unexpected issues such as this.

#### **Next Steps:**

• As we approach the summative test window opening, if a solution is not reached, ODE and CAI will share needed actions at a later time.

Overview	Ensure OSAS training requirements are fulfilled for various users.
Important Events	<ul> <li>Make the <u>30-Day Notice and Opt-Out Form</u> available no later than 30 days before the opening of the summative testing window (published in 12 languages on ODE's <u>Test Administration</u> webpage)</li> </ul>
DTC Responsibilities	<ul> <li>Ongoing: Ensure that STCs, TAs, QTs, and QAs complete appropriate training (and then receive associated test group permissions) prior to administering tests</li> <li>Ongoing: Ensure that all personnel who will be present in the testing environment have signed the appropriate Assurance of Test Security form, available under the "Forms" menu of ODE's <u>Test Administration</u> webpage</li> <li>Ongoing: Work with appropriate district and school personnel to set student accessibility feature(s) in TIDE</li> <li>Ongoing: Distribute <u>Remote Test Administration permission forms</u>, as applicable (available in seven languages under the "Remote Testing Resources" menu of ODE's <u>Test Administration</u> webpage)</li> </ul>

Overview	ELPA and Alt ELPA testing windows open.
Important Events	<ul> <li>Testing window opens for ELPA Summative and Alt ELPA</li> <li>Testing window opens for NAEP</li> <li>ARUA, AWE, and SAR applications open</li> </ul>
DTC Responsibilities	<ul> <li>Confirm that STCs, TAs, QTs, and QAs are ready for the opening of the testing window</li> <li>Ensure student accessibility feature(s) are set in TIDE (ongoing)</li> <li>Conduct TA training, including remote administration as needed, and add relevant test groups in TIDE (ongoing)</li> <li>Orders due for <u>Braille &amp; Large Print Forms for ORExt</u></li> <li>Provide first-line technical support to TAs throughout the testing window</li> <li><u>Report potential test improprieties and irregularities</u> to ODE and implement ODE-indicated action<sup>1</sup></li> </ul>
