

The window for administration of the Grade 11 in-person and remote English Language Arts (ELA), Math and Science tests (both general and extended) opened **February 6, 2024**.

## **Test Impropriety Process**

Q: What does ODE plan to do with the data collected by the new (2023-24) question on the impropriety form, "Did the incident result in possible IDEA non-compliance (e.g., violation of a student's IEP or 504 plan)?"

A: This information is reviewed by ODE staff to ensure that corrective action is planned for potential IDEA non-compliance. In some cases, information may be shared with the Office of Enhancing Student Opportunities (OESO) to help ODE better support districts.

ODE action regarding student test records are based on the DTC's report, as in prior years.

#### **PreACT Reminder**

- ORS 329.488 directs ODE to provide a statewide opportunity for all eligible Oregon 10th grade students enrolled in a public school to access a nationally-normed college entrance practice exam. That required practice exam is the PreACT.
- Test Window: 10/2/2023 4/9/2024
- PreACT order window closes 3/21 DTCs can order materials through the <u>College and Career</u>
  <u>Readiness Information System (CCRIS)</u> by selecting the OREGON GRADE 10 ONLY option.

## Proposed ELPA Summative Proficiency Designation

• "Provisionally Proficient" is a proposed proficiency designation (i.e. a *test result*) on the K-12 ELPA Summative (no other ELPA test).

Emerging → Progressing → Provisionally Proficient → Proficient

- For students who score "just above" or "just below" the Proficient threshold
- Parent/guardian/adult student makes the final exiting decision

The final decision about whether to move forward with this policy will be made after gathering feedback at the COSA Multilingual and English Learner conference this coming March. If approved, this proficiency designation would be available on the **2024-25 ELPA Summative**.
